The PennDOT District Office wanted to push back the paving of this roadway but Jeff stated that the road needs to be paved. He also stated that he has the funding in place for the project. Unless something major happen over winter the road will be paved in 2024. A resident asked if PennDOT will cut trees off utility lines. Jeff stated no, due to safety issues PennDOT will not touch the trees.
 - b. SR 2001 – Jeff stated that SR 2001 is closed in Delaware Township. There is an improved 45 miles detour in place. Project should be done by the end of October.
