

## PIKE COUNTY ROAD TASK FORCE MINUTES

September 21, 2023

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** 2:00 pm
2. **ROLL CALL:** Brian Snyder, Rich Bailo, Ellen Enslin, Jeff Luongo, Tim Rohner, Guy Cook, Jay Knapp, Joe Dunne, Jon Mee, Damion Green, Shane Williams, Commissioner Osterberg, Jill Gamboni, Daniel Yelito, Charles DeFebo, Ken Coutts and Mike Mrozinski.
3. **PUBLIC COMMENT**— None
4. **APPROVAL of MINUTES-** Motion to approve August 17, 2023, minutes made by Jay Knapp. Seconded by Guy Cook. All in Favor. Motion Passed.
5. **CORRESPONDENCE** – Brian Snyder reported that the Road Task force received two pieces of correspondence since the last meeting. The first was notification of additional paving being done on Route 6 near the intersection of 6/434 near the carwash. The second was the Road Safety Audit report that was provided by PennDOT District 4-0. Brian stated that 4-0 came to Pike County to meet with County staff and NEPA MPO staff to review and discuss several intersections around the county.
6. **PennDOT UPDATES** – See attached – Commissioner Osterberg asked about additional roadway sweeping of Route 6 near Eureka Stone Quarry. He also asked if there will be additional warnings about SR 209 over Sawkill Creek Bridge. Jeff Luongo stated that there will be additional public meetings about the bridge project including information on the temporary bridge.
7. **COUNTY/MUNICIPAL UPDATES** – Commissioner Osterberg stated that the County owned bridge on Carlton Hill Road will be moving along faster due to a recently awarded PennDOT Multi-modal grant that Brian Snyder wrote on behalf of the County.

  - a. US 209 Update – Jon Mee introduced Damion Green who is the Maintenance Supervisor for the area. Damion stated that the paving project that started last year will be completed in 2024 and the two slides north of SR 739 will be fixed during that time.
  - b. Crosswalks on 7<sup>th</sup> Street in Milford Borough – Jeff stated that the crosswalks are the municipalities responsibility to install and maintain.

  - e. National Park Service – Under new business

11. **MISCELLANEOUS** – Ellen Enslin from the Pike County Conservation District shared that there is still funding available for Dirt & Gravel/Low Volume Road projects. The District must spend this money by June 2024 or it will be sent back to the State. She shared that there will be a municipal day on Tuesday that will include a bus tour of the region showcasing recently completed Dirt Road projects.
