AARP Foundation's Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) helps make connections between older adults looking to return to the workforce and employers. For more than 45 years, the program has provided Americans 55 and older with opportunities to fill entry-level and mid-level positions with employers in their communities.

AARP Foundation SCSEP provides both community services and work-based training for participants. Individuals are placed in a wide variety of activities at non-profit and public facilities like day cares, senior centers, schools and hospitals. This on-the-job training experience can then be used as a bridge to find employment opportunities outside of the program.

In addition to job and community service placement, AARP Foundation SCSEP provides participants with training and support services that are important for finding future employment, like Individual Employment Plan (IEP) development, specialized training, wages and fringe benefits, annual physicals, assistance in securing future employment and access to local American Job Centers—formerly known as One-Stop Career Centers.
