

Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Annual Report Pike County Correctional Facility 2023

In 2022 The Pike County Correctional Facility received seventeen (17) PREA allegations. All of these allegations were comprehensively investigated by Certified PREA Investigators. Zero (0) of these allegations were deemed Substantiated. Six (6) of these allegations were deemed as Unsubstantiated. Eleven (11) of these allegations were deemed as Unfounded.


In 2023 The Pike County Correctional Facility received nine (9) PREA allegations. All of these allegations were comprehensively investigated by Certified PREA Investigators. Zero (0) of these allegations were deemed Substantiated. Four (4) of these allegations were deemed as Unsubstantiated. Five (5) of these allegations were deemed as Unfounded.

Due to no significant increase or decrease in PREA allegations over the last two years no changes in facility policy or modifications in facility monitoring systems are necessary. Over the last two (2) years zero (0) Substantiated allegations were identified by Certified Facility Investigators.
