

ORDINANCE #26-91B

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #26-91 A ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE CITIZENS OF PINCONNING TOWNSHIP FROM LAWSUITS, RECRIMINATIONS AND/OR FINES RESULTING FROM THE OPERATION OF ANY SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY, OR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, LOCATED WITHIN SAID TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD, OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PINCONNING, THAT ORDINANCE #26-91A, ADOPTED THE 23rd DAY OF OCTOBER, 1991, SHALL BE AND IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

2 - DEFINITIONS:

FOR THE PURPOSES OF ORDINANCE #26-91A, AND IT'S AMENDMENTS, THESE DEFINITIONS ARE SET FORTH AND INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE HEREIN.

(a) A solid waste disposal facility means any type I, II, or III sanitary landfill.

(b) A solid waste management system means a set of procedures which provide for the collection, transportation, separation, recycling, recovery and disposal of solid waste.

(c) A citizen means residential property owners who generate only household waste.

In all other respects the said Ordinance #26-91A shall remain in full force and effect except as hereby modified.

EFFECTIVE

This amendment to Ordinance #26-91A, being necessary for the regulation of the general health, safety and welfare of the persons in Pinconning Township, shall become effective upon publication in the Pinconning Journal, a newspaper of circulation within said township.
