ORDINANCE NO. II - A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I, PARAGRAPH A OF  
ORDINANCE NO. I ESTABLISHING RATES, CHARGES,  
RULES AND REGULATION FOR THE USE AND  
SERVICE OF THE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF PINCONNING  
DISTRICT NO. I

The Township of Pinconning, County of Bay, and  
State of Michigan ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: There shall be and there are hereby  
established quarterly rates and charges for the use of and  
for the services supplied by the Township's water supply  
system as follows:

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be published in  
full in the Pinconning Journal, a newspaper of general  
circulation in the Township. Promptly after its adoption,  
it shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township  
and authenticated and filed in other places as may be required  
by law.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby determined by the Township Board to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Township and is, therefore, declared to have immediate effect.
