-16		Operator means any person who operates or is
17		in actual physical control of a snowmobile.
18		Operate:
19		Means to ride in or on and be in actual physical
20		control of the operation of a snowmobile.
21		Snowmobile:
22		Means any motor driven vehicle designed for
23		travel primarily on snow or ice of a type which
24		utilizes sled type runners or skis, or an
25		endless belt tread, or any combination of skis
26		or any other Similar means of contact with the
27		surface upon which it is operated.
28		Highway or Street:
29	1	Leans the entire width between the boundary
30		lines of every way publicly maintained when any
31		part thereof is open to the use of the public
32		for purposes of vehicular traffic.

E. ROADWAY:

. 16

Means that portion of the highway improved, designated or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic. If a highway includes two or more separate roadways, the term roadway refers to any such roadway separately, but not to all such roadways collectively.

F. Right of Way:

Means that portion of a highway less the roadway and any shoulder.

G. Shoulder:

Means that portion of a highway on either side of a roadway which is normally snow plowed for the safety and convenience of vehicular traffic.

II.

upon a public highway or street
No person shall operate a snowmobile within the
Township of Pinconning, County of Bay and State of Michigan,
except under the following conditions and circumstances:

- way of a public highway except a limited access highway if it is operated at the extreme right of the open portion of the right of way and with the flow of traffic on the highway; Provided, however, that all snowmobiles so operated shall proceed in a single file.
- B. A snowmobile may be operated on the roadway or shoulder when necessary to cross a bridge or culvert if the snowmobile is brought to a complete stop before entering the roadway or shoulder, and the driver yields the right of way to any approaching vehicle on the highway.
- C. A snowmobile may be operated across a public highway other than a limited access highway, at

the Statutes of the State of Michigan. In any forest, nursery, planting area or public land posted or reasonably identifiable as an area of forest reproduction when growing stock may be damaged. Within 100 feet of a dwelling between twelve midnight D. and six a.m. at a speed greater than minimum required to maintain power of movement of the snowmobile. 10 In or upon or remain unlawfully on premises which E. 11 are fenced, otherwise enclosed in a manner to 12 exclude intruders, posted in a conspicuous manner 13 or when notice against trespass is personally communicated to him by the owner or an authorized 14 person, nor in or upon any farm lands, farm woodlots, 15 or platted property without permission of the 16 17 landowner. 18 On or across a cemetery or burial ground. 13 V. No snowmobile shall be parked on any roadway or shoulder 20 except in an emergency situation. 21 22 VI. All snowmobiles shall at all times give way to all 23 24 vehicular traffic and the operator of such snowmobile shall at 25 all times obey all traffic signs, signals and devices. 26 VII. Any person found guilty of violating the terms and 28 provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and 29 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00, or 90 days in jail, 30 or both, at the discretion of the Court. 31 THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE AFFECT ON THE 12th 32
