

**PINCONNING TOWNSHIP

ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT  
ORDINANCE NO. 17-04**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Pinconning Township, Bay County, Michigan, held at the Pinconning Township Hall on October 3, 2017, at 10:00am., Township Board Member Beck moved to adopt the following ordinance, which motion was seconded by Township Board Member Switek :

*An Ordinance to amend the Pinconning Township Zoning Ordinance, as amended, to clarify that Commercial Medical Marijuana Grower Facilities of Class A, Class B, or Class C are permitted as special uses within Pinconning Township.*

THE TOWNSHIP OF PINCONNING ORDAINS:

**Section 1. Amendment of Article VI, Section 6.10.3, Uses Permitted by Special Use Permit:** The Pinconning Township Zoning Ordinance, Article VI, Section 6.10.3 shall be amended to permit Class A, Class B or Class C Grower Facilities as follows:

Section 6.10.3 Uses Permitted by Special Permit.

The following uses are permitted in the CMM Overlay District with a Special Use Permit granted by the Township Board, after review and recommendation by the Planning Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Article V - Special Use Permits:

- a. Primary Caregiver Operation
- b. Provisioning Center
- c. Grower Facility
- d. Safety Compliance Facility
- e. Processor Facility
- f. Secure Transporter Facility

**Section 2. Amendment of Article VI, Section 6.8.5, Uses Permitted by Special Permit:** The Pinconning Township Zoning Ordinance, Article VI, Section 6.8.5, Uses Permitted by Special Use Permit, shall be amended to permit Class A, Class B or Class C Grower Facilities as follows:

Section 6.8.5 Uses Permitted by Special Permit.

The following uses are permitted in the LI District with a Special Use Permit granted by the Township Board, after review and recommendation by the Planning Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Article V - Special Use Permits:

- a. Primary Caregiver Operation

- b. Grower Facility
- c. Processor Facility

**Section 3. Severability:** The provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable. If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, that declaration does not affect or impair the validity of all other provisions that are not subject to that declaration.

**Section 4. Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall take effect seven (7) days after publication of a notice of adoption of this Ordinance, unless referendum procedures are initiated under MCL 125.3402. If referendum procedures are initiated, this Ordinance will take effect in accordance with MCL 125.3402.
