RESOLUTION OF CONCURRENCE

WHEREAS, THE Township of Pinconning, Bay County, Michigan has established a Township Planning Commission under the terms of the Township Planning Commission Act, Act 168 of the Public Acts of 1959, to provide for Township Planning; and


WHEREAS, said Planning Commission has made inquiries, investigations and surveys of all the resources of the Township and assembled and analyzed data and formulated plans for the proper conservation and uses of all resources, including a determination of the extent of probable future need for the most advantageous designation of lands having various use potentials and for services, facilities, and utilities required to equip such lands; and


WHEREAS, said Planning Commission held on November 9, 1978 a Public Hearing, as required by law, to provide an opportunity for citizens to express opinions, ask questions, and discuss all aspects of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission took the comments of Citizens made at the Public Hearing under advisement and subsequently adopted said plan on December 7, 1978, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, this 12th day of February, 1979, that the Pinconning Township Board of Trustees do hereby concur with the goals and policies formulated by the Township Planning Commission as depicted on the Land Use Plan Map and as discussed in the accompanying text, and be it futher

RESOLVED, that the Pinconning Township Board of Trustees shall employ said goals and policies as established in the Land Use Plan as a basis for their evaluation of future development proposals and future rezoning petitions.
