The Township of Pinconning and its officials are preforming the duties of office as prescribed by law, to the best of our ability. Again it is my understanding, the Michigan Township Association's "Defense Fund" is for the protection of active members, and not previous officials with only personal gain as their incentive.

To reiterate, we the Pinconning Township Board, ask for any help available, Financially and Morally in the above
