

**PINCONNING TOWNSHIP  
RESOLUTION ALLOWING TEMPORARY OPERATION OF  
COMMERCIAL MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITIES**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-13**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Pinconning Township, Bay County, Michigan, held at the Pinconning Township Hall on December 12, 2017 at 4:00 pm.

The following resolution was offered by Switek and supported by Arbuck:

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2017, Pinconning Township, through its Township Board adopted an ordinance implementing Section 205 of the Michigan Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act, Public Act 281 of 2016 (the "Act"), specifically Ordinance No. 17-01, as amended; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2017 the Bureau of Medical Marihuana Regulation (the "Bureau") has adopted and filed Emergency Rules with the Secretary of State for the purpose of implementing the Act; and

WHEREAS, under Rule 19 of the Emergency Rules, a municipality may authorize the temporary operation of a commercial medical marihuana facility until June 15, 2018, and Pinconning Township wishes to authorize the temporary operation of commercial medical marihuana facilities by applicants with local approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Board of Pinconning, Bay County, Michigan, as follows:

1. After Township Board approval of an application for issuance of a commercial medical marihuana facility permit and related special use permit, an applicant with a valid Township permit to operate a facility, may submit all necessary forms and documents as specified by the Bureau to the Township Clerk for review and approval for temporary operation. The Clerk or her designee may take necessary action as required by the Bureau, including execution of an attestation form provided by the Bureau, to authorize temporary operation of the commercial medical marihuana facility within the Township.

2. Applicants, owners, operators, employees, and agents engaging in the temporary operation of a commercial medical marihuana facility under the Act and Rule 19 of the Emergency Rules must comply with all other applicable laws, rules, and regulations, including but not limited to Pinconning Township Ordinance 17-01, as amended; the Pinconning Township Zoning Ordinance, building codes; health codes; applicable rules of the Bureau; and any other

law, rule, or regulation for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Pinconning Township.

3. Any commercial medical marihuana facility approved for temporary operation in the Township must cease such temporary use on or before June 15, 2018. Any continued operation after such date must be under a state license to permanently operate a commercial medical marihuana facility.

4. The Township may revoke approval to temporarily operate from any licensee that has violated any applicable law, rule, or regulation for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Pinconning Township as provided by Pinconning Township ordinances and state law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.


