

**RESOLUTION TO OPPOSE ANY PROPOSAL TO  
REDUCE OR ELIMINATE MICHIGAN STATE POLICE  
PRESENCE IN TOWNSHIPS**

**WHEREAS**, rural townships in Michigan have relied on the Michigan State Police to provide police services for many years, and

**WHEREAS**, rural townships in Michigan are subject to significant revenue sharing reductions during the next fiscal year, and

**WHEREAS**, the limited resources available to provide services in rural townships are and have been insufficient to allow funding of contracted police services, and

**WHEREAS**, if the community policing services provided to rural townships by the Michigan State Police are curtailed or eliminated, many rural townships will not have police services, and

**WHEREAS**, police services are essential services for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of rural townships, now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pinconning Township Board of Trustees is emphatically opposed to any reduction or elimination of Michigan State Police posts or any Michigan State Police presence in rural townships.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this resolution be sent to Governor Granholm and to our state legislators.
