SLOW-NO WAKE ORDINANCE STATE OF MINNESOTA, COUNTY OF PINE ORDINANCE NO. 2020-63

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SURFACE USE OF POKEGAMA LAKE, CROSS LAKE, AND THE SNAKE RIVER BETWEEN SAID LAKES.

Section 1: PURPOSE, INTENT AND APPLICATION: As authorized by Minnesota Statutes 86B.201, 86B.205, and 459.20, AND Minnesota Rules 6110.3000 - 6110.3800 as now in effect and as hereafter amended, this Ordinance is enacted for the purpose and with the intent to control and regulate the use of the waters of Pokegama Lake, Cross Lake, and the segment of the Snake River between said lakes in Pine County, Minnesota, said bodies of water being located entirely within the boundaries of Pine County to promote its fullest use and enjoyment by the public in general and the citizens of Pine County in particular, to ensure safety for persons and property in connection with the use of said waters; to harmonize and integrate the varying uses of said waters; and to promote the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Pine County, Minnesota.

Section 2: DEFINITIONS: Terms used in this ordinance related to boating are defined in M.S. § 86B.005.

<u>Section 3:</u> SLOW-NO WAKE speed 24 hours per day shall be required on Pokegama Lake, Cross Lake, and the section of the Snake River between said lakes when any of the following conditions is met:

- A.) When Pokegama Lake's water elevation is at or above 935.5' (NGVD29); or
- B.) When Cross Lake's water elevation is at or above 935.0' (NGVD29); or
- C.) When the United States Geological Stream Gauge Station 05338500, located near the Cross Lake Outlet, is at 6'.

When high water levels have subsided and have remained below said elevations stated above for three (3) consecutive days, said restrictions shall be promptly removed.

<u>Section 4:</u> ENFORCEMENT: The Primary responsibility for enforcement of this ordinance shall rest with the Pine County Sheriff's Department. This, however, shall not preclude enforcement by other licensed peace officers.

<u>Section 5:</u> EXEMPTIONS: All authorized Resource Management, Emergency and Enforcement Personnel, while acting in the performance of their assigned duties are exempt from the foregoing restrictions.

<u>Section 6:</u> NOTIFICATION: It shall be the responsibility of the *Pine County* to provide for adequate notification of the public, which shall include placement of a sign at each public watercraft access outlining essential elements of the ordinance, as well as the placement of necessary buoys and signs.

<u>Section 7:</u> PENALTIES: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

<u>Section 8:</u> EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its passage and publication.



PINE COUNTY ORDINANCE 2020-63 SUMMARY

An ordinance regulating the surface use of Pokegama Lake, Cross Lake, and the Snake River between said lakes, which:

Requires slow-no wake speed 24 hours per day when any of the following conditions is met.

When Pokegama Lake's water elevation is at or above 935.5' (NGVD29); or

When Cross Lake's water elevation is at or above 935.0' (NGVD29); or

When the United States Geological Stream Gauge Station 05338500, located near the Cross Lake Outlet, is at 6'.

When high water levels have subsided and have remained below said elevations stated above for three (3) consecutive days, said restrictions shall be promptly lifted.

The Primary responsibility for enforcement of this ordinance shall rest with the Pine County Sheriff's Department. This, however, shall not preclude enforcement by other licensed peace officers.
