



The Riverside Fire Department conducted a fire and life safety inspection of your mobile food preparation vehicle. The inspection was conducted based on the requirements of the Heart of America (HOA) Fire Marshal's Association. At the time of the inspection your food preparation vehicle passed all the requirements to receive the HOA sticker.

As a mobile food preparation vehicle vendor, you are required to follow all other requirements by jurisdictions/cities in which you provide food services. This could include operational permits and/or business licenses from each jurisdiction. Other jurisdictions/cities may require an additional safety inspection to ensure that nothing has changed since this inspection.

Please consult with each city/jurisdiction that you wish to provide food services in for any additional requirements.

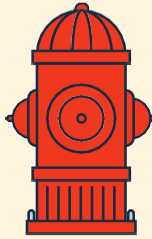

Maintain 10 feet separation between each mobile food truck and/or structure.



Ensure the placement of the concession vehicle does not interfere with fire lanes, fire breaks, fire hydrants, egress or exit access of any proximate structures.



Make sure your employees know the location of and how to operate the fire extinguishers.



Follow safe food handling guidelines and maintain a clean workspace.



Train your employees on the location of and how to shut off the power and/or gas in case of an emergency.
