ORDINANCE NUMBER XXX-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 380 "SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING", ARTICLE III "DUMPING", SECTION 13 "VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES" AND SECTION 14 "TRUCKS NOT TO REMAIN ON STREETS" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSELLE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Roselle (hereinafter "the Borough") is experiencing an increase in unauthorized overnight parking by trucks and other vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to protect residents from uninvited nuisance, ensure private enjoyment of residents' property, and preserve the low-density character of residential areas within the municipality; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roselle, that the Code of the Borough of Roselle, Chapter 380, Article III "Dumping", is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

SECTION II. The Code of the Borough of Roselle, Part IV, General Ordinances, Chapter 380 Solid Waste and Recycling, Article III Dumping, Section 13, entitled "Violations and penalties" is hereby amended and supplemented to include the following (additions in **bold**, deletions struck through):

§ 380-13 Violations and Penalties.

Any person violating any provision of this article shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$250 \$100 nor more than \$2,000 \$1,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION III. The code of the Borough of Roselle, Part IV General Ordinances, Chapter 380 Solid Waste and Recycling, Article III Dumping, Section 14, entitled "Trucks not to remain on streets" is hereby supplemented to include the following (additions in **bold**):

§ 380-14 Trucks not to remain on streets.

No truck or other vehicle containing litter which has been transported into the Borough or from one point in the Borough to another shall be parked or allowed to remain standing on any street in the Borough or any public property for a period in excess of two hours. Additionally, no truck or such vehicle shall be allowed to remain parked overnight on any street or public property within the Borough. Violators shall be subject to fines and penalties defined under § 380-13.

SECTION IV. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed severable.

SECTION V. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby replaced and/or repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.

RESOLUTION GRANTING A TEMPORARY ENTERTAINMENT LICENSE TO IT'S A VIBE EVENTS, LLC

WHEREAS, On November 20, 2010, the Borough of Roselle adopted Ordinance Number 2386-10; codified in the Borough code as Chapter 190, requiring any public dance hall, public assembly hall, nightclub, cabaret, theater, movie house, social club, restaurant and/or any person, partnership or corporation holding a plenary retail consumption license, occupying any buildings or parts of buildings, to obtain an entertainment license therefore from the Borough of Roselle; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance, an Applicant It's A Vibe Events, LLC, is required to obtain an entertainment license with the Borough of Roselle; and

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSELLE COUNCIL SUPPORTING MOM & POP SHOP, LLC'S APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY CANNABIS REGULATORY COMMISSION FOR A CLASS 5 CANNABIS RETAILER LICENSE AND CONFIRMING THAT THE INTENDED SITE IS SUITABLE FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE PROPOSED CANNABIS RETAILER

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Roselle ("Borough") previously adopted Resolution No. 2023-172 in support of the application of Mom & Pop Shop, LLC ("Mom & Pop Shop") to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("CRC") for an annual license to operate a cannabis retailer; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has since been informed by Mom & Pop Shop that the intended address of their proposed cannabis retail business has changed, and that the new proposed site is located at 360 W. 1st Avenue ("Site"), identified as Block 5301, Lot 6 on the current Official Tax Map of the Borough of Roselle; and

WHEREAS, Mom & Pop Shop has provided the Borough with information regarding their proposed cannabis business at the Site; and

WHEREAS, the Site is located in the Commercial-Industrial Zone, where "Cannabis Retailer" is a conditionally permitted use pursuant to Borough Code § 650-99(B)(3)(L), provided that the following conditions set forth in Borough Code § 650-102(B)(8) are met:

- (a) All other regulations applicable to the zoning district are complied with:
- (b) The establishment is licensed and located more than 1,000 feet from the property line of any elementary or secondary school property; and
 - (c) The establishment does not include an outdoor consumption area; and

WHEREAS, the zoning officer of the Borough has analyzed the applicable law and public records and has made such other inquiries as necessary and opined that the Site permits the operation of a cannabis retailer if the conditions contained in Borough Code § 650-102(B)(8) are met; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Borough Code § 155-5(I) and (J), a maximum of three (3) Class 5 cannabis retailers may obtain a local license to operate within the Borough (with two (2)

- additional Class 5 licenses available for businesses that qualify as a microbusiness under N.J.S.A. 24:6I-33); and
- WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, the issuance of a Class 5 cannabis retailer license to Mom & Pop Shop would not exceed the applicable limit of three (3) Class 5 licensed cannabis retailers within the Borough; and
- WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 24:6I-36 and N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.10 require applicants to the CRC for a state cannabis business license to submit proof of local support for the suitability of a cannabis business's proposed location, which is demonstrated by a resolution adopted by the municipality's governing body; and
- WHEREAS, provided that all applicable conditions and requirements of the Borough Code are met, the Site permits the operation of a Class 5 licensed cannabis retailer; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough Council believes that permitting Mom & Pop Shop to operate a cannabis retailer at the Site will satisfy patients' and consumers' interests and help create jobs and economic opportunity within the Borough.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Roselle, County of Union, State of New Jersey, that above recitals are incorporated as though set forth at length herein, and that the Borough of Roselle supports Mom & Pop Shop's application to the CRC for a Class 5 Cannabis Retailer Annual License.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, while the Borough Code establishes a limit of three Class 5 cannabis retailers that may operate within the Borough (with two additional licenses available for microbusinesses), license applicants that receive CRC approval first in time shall be deemed approved by the municipality until the local license limit is reached.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution of Support does not obligate the Borough to issue a license to this applicant in the event the Borough determines that issuance of such license is inconsistent with the criteria set forth in the Borough Code.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the zoning officer or appropriate official of the Borough be authorized to issue any required letter or affidavit confirming that the proposed Site is located within a zone that permits cannabis retailers upon the satisfaction of the conditions set forth hereinabove.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be sent to Jeff Brown, Executive Director of the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission, together with a request that the CRC timely inform the Borough prior to the CRC's approval of any annual license application (including an application to convert a conditional license to an annual license) that would result in the above-described local license limit being reached or exceeded, so that the Borough may advise the CRC of the number of remaining available licenses and provide the CRC with the Borough's preferences as to licensure.
