LEAF PICK-UP SCHEDULE LEAVES ONLY!



LEAVES ARE PICKED-UP BY WARDS (1-5) STARTING
NOVEMBER 6, 2023 THROUGH **MARCH 1, 2024** AS FOLLOWS:

MONDAY - 1st WARD
TUESDAY - 2nd WARD

WEDNESDAY - 3RD WARD
THURSDAY - 4th WARD

FRIDAY - 5th WARD

THERE WILL BE A TEN (10) BAG PICK-UP LIMIT AND FIFTY (50) POUND WEIGHT LIMIT PER BAG/PER PICK-UP.

WE ENCOURAGE THE BIO-DEGRADABLE PAPER BAG USAGE **ONLY!** IN THE EVENT YOU HAVE NO MORE BAGS; LEAVES WILL ONLY BE PICKED-UP IN A 35 GALLON STURDY CONTAINER OR SMALLER WITH A (50) POUND WEIGHT LIMIT.

If A Ward Falls on A Holiday; Leaves Will Be Picked Up Your Next Scheduled Pick-Up

- ANY BRANCHES/TREE PARTS THAT COME DOWN AS A RESULT OF AN EMERGENCY/STORM, MUST BE CALLED IN TO THE PUBLIC WORKS AND AN APPOINTMENT WILL BE MADE TO PICK-UP. (908) 245-2920
- PLEASE HELP KEEP PUBLIC STREETS CLEAR AT CURBLINE BY RAKING UP LEAVES ALONG THE CURB IN FRONT OF YOUR RESIDENCE AND BAGGING THEM. THIS WILL HELP WITH THE SWEEPING OF THE STREETS.
- DO NOT PUT ANYTHING OR BLOCK THE CATCH BASINS/STORM DRAINS WITH DEBRIS AS THIS AFFECTS WILDLIFE AND CAN CAUSE FLOODING.
- WE ASK ALL RESIDENTS TO HELP US TO HELP YOU.

NO BRANCHES, TREE PARTS, STUMPS, GRASS CLIPPINGS, WOOD CHIPS, PINE CONES/ BRUSH WILL BE COLLECTED UNTIL APRIL, 2024 DUE TO SPACE LIMITATIONS.



NO FOREIGN MATTER SUCH AS CANS, GARBAGE, DIRT, GRAVEL/STONES, PAPER, CONTAMINATED MATERIALS OR ANY OTHER DEBRIS CAN BE MIXED WITH THE LEAVES.
