

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY OF SOUTHGATE  
BY AMENDING CHAPTER 468.01 PARKING ON REFUSE PICK-UP DAYS AND CHAPTER 468.99  
PENALTY.

Preamble

The City of Southgate City Council approved at their regular meeting of July 6, 2022 that the Southgate City Codified Ordinance for Chapter 468.01 Parking on Refuse Pick-up Days and Chapter 468.99 Penalty be amended as follows:

Section 1.

CHAPTER 468.01 PARKING ON REFUSE PICK-UP DAYS

- (a) No person shall park a motor vehicle upon any public street within a residential zone of the City *between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.* on respective refuse pick-up days within each zone, except for the following legal holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
- (b) All vehicles found in violation of this section may be removed from the street at the owner's expense. This expense includes, but is not limited to, towing fees and any storage fees that may accrue as a result of such towing. Such fees shall be paid prior to the owner receiving his or her motor vehicle from the City.
- (c) Appropriate signs shall be posted designating "*No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.* on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday."
- (d) This Section shall not apply to streets within the City that are unpaved.

CHAPTER 468.99 PENALTY

- (a) Whoever violates Section 468.01 is responsible for a civil infraction and shall be fined *Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00)* for a first offense and *fifty dollars (\$50.00)* for the second offense and all subsequent offenses. This shall re-set on January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.


**Section 2. Saving Clause.** Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.


**Section 3. Severability.** Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction or by any state agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holdings shall be construed and limited to such work, sentence, phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be so invalid shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any of the remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4. Conflicting Ordinances.** All prior existing ordinances adopted by the City of Southgate inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.
