WAYNE COUNTY TO ENHANCE NORTHLINE ROAD IN THE CITY OF SOUTHGATE

Road Rehabilitation Improvements on Northline Road to Start on April 15th

WAYNE COUNTY, MI – Wayne County Department of Public Services will begin the road rehabilitation project of 0.74 miles of Northline Road from Agnes Street to 100' West of Fort Street (M-85), in the City of Southgate.

The project will include concrete base course repairs and curb cap patching, asphalt resurfacing, drainage structure adjustments, driveway approach replacements, installation of concrete sidewalk and ADA sidewalk ramps, as well as the application of pavement markings and new signage.

Construction is scheduled to begin on **Monday, April 15, 2024** and is expected to be completed by Summer 2024, barring any unforeseen delays or inclement weather.

During construction, one lane of traffic in each direction will be open at all times. Speed limits and load restrictions may be reduced as needed. Access to all residences and businesses along Northline Road will be maintained throughout the project duration.

Flaggers will be present as needed. Please use caution while traveling through work zones.
