

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GENERAL PREVAILING HOURLY WAGE RATES  
FOR ALL LABORERS, MECHANICS AND OTHER WORKMEN EMPLOYED FOR WORK CONTRACTED  
BY STEPHENSON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State of Illinois that a rate of no less than the general prevailing hourly rate as paid for work of similar character in the locality in which the work is performed, shall be paid to all laborers, mechanics and other workmen, by or on behalf of any and all public bodies engaged in public works, and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, therefore, has enacted "An Act Regulating Wages of Labors, Mechanics and other Workmen employed in any Public Works by the State, County, City, or any Public Body or any Political Subdivision or by anyone under Contract for Public Works", 820 ILCS 130/1 through 130/12, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes 1992, and

WHEREAS, 130/9 of the aforesaid Act requires that Stephenson County, each fiscal year, establish the general prevailing rate of hourly wages to paid laborers, mechanics, and other workmen in the locality of Stephenson County, Illinois, employed by contractors or subcontractors in performing construction and maintenance of public works contracted for by Stephenson County, Illinois.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF STEPHENSON COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS THAT:

SECTION 1: Contractors or subcontractors doing construction and maintenance of public works for Stephenson County, Illinois shall pay the general prevailing rate of hourly wages to all laborers, mechanics, and other workmen employed by them as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois for the locality of Stephenson County.

SECTION 2: The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Resolution to be published in a local newspaper of general circulation, to publicly post and keep available for public inspection in the Office of the County Clerk this determination, or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage, and to promptly file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Illinois Department of Labor at Springfield, Illinois, all as by law prescribed where after the same shall be in force and effect as by law provided.

SECTION 3: The general prevailing rate of hourly wages for all labors, mechanics, and other workmen hereby adopted shall be in effect for Stephenson County, Illinois beginning June 1, 2018 and ending May 31, 2019.

RESOLUTION  
PREVAILING WAGE RATES FOR STEPHENSON COUNTY EMPLOYEES  
ENGAGED IN PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the law in accord with provisions of "An act regulating the wage of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any Public Works by the State, County, City or any Public Body of any political subdivision or anyone under contract for Public Works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, requires that the Public Body awarding the contract for Public Works shall determine the Prevailing Wage Rates for persons engaged in such work.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Stephenson County, Illinois, that the general prevailing wage rates per hour for all laborers, workmen, and mechanics employed by the County of Stephenson, Illinois engaged in Public Works is ascertained as follows:

- \$17.03     Truck Drivers
- \$17.97f    Mechanics
- \$17.03     Tractor Operators, Shovel Operators, Motor Grader Operators, Crusher Operators
- \$17.03     Roller Operator
- \$17.03     Gravel Spreader Operator, Paver Operator, Pug Mill Operator
- \$17.03     Laborer

The rates shown above do not contain fringe benefits. The rates for overtime are one and one-half those shown above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk of Stephenson County, Illinois, shall keep available in her office, a copy of this determination of General Prevailing Wage Rates as above for inspection by any interested party and shall file a copy of this Resolution with the office of the Illinois Department of Labor at Springfield, Illinois, as required by law.
