AGENDA ITEM: Call to Order

Mayor White called the regular Council meeting to order. Councilmembers, Sachs, Weatherly, Mitchell, Huster and Smith were present, along with City Administrator Selby.

AGENDA ITEM: Call to Order

AGENDA ITEM: Agenda Approval

Councilman Weatherly made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilman Watkins seconded the motion. All Councilmembers voted “aye”

AGENDA ITEM: September 12, 2016 Regular Meeting Minutes

Councilman Sachs made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 12, 2016 meeting. Councilman Watkins seconded the motion. All councilmembers voted “aye”.

AGENDA ITEM: Bills

Councilman Smith made a motion to approve the bills to be paid. Councilman Huster seconded the motion. All Councilmembers voted “aye”

AGENDA ITEM: Citizen Comments

Christina Dornroffer, 410 Evergreen said that she is concerned about her neighbor’s dogs barking late at night. Her neighbor has four dogs that bark from 6:30 PM to 11 PM. The police chief said that he had sent the complaint to the city prosecutor.

AGENDA ITEM: New Business

Bridge Bid: A motion was made by Councilman Huster and seconded by Councilman Sachs to approve the low bid from Cahill’s Construction for a bridge replacement on North Meramec Street. All Councilmembers voted “aye”.

Substation Breaker Replacement Bid: Councilman Sachs made a motion to accept the lowest bid from Shaffers Sub Construction for replacement of the breakers at the Phelps Substation. Councilman Smith seconded. All Councilmembers voted “aye”.

Ordinance No. 16-1087 MPUA Mutual Aid Agreement. Councilman Watkins made a motion to enter into a mutual Aid Agreement with the MPUA. Councilman Huster seconded the motion. All Councilmembers voted “aye”.

AGENDA ITEM: Department Reports

Police: Councilman Sachs reported that the Police are doing a great job. The Police Chief had to apprehend a subject by running across Interstate 44. Police Chief Jones said he would be meeting with the school board on the 20th to discuss a resource office.

Public Works Director: Lyle Thomas reported on the storm water ditches being cleaned and other projects being done.

Street: Councilman Huster gave a report on the street department.

Sanitation: Councilman Watkins gave a report on the sanitation department. He said the Tri-County Humane Society is still putting animal waste in the trash.

IDA: Councilman Sachs reported no meeting this month.
