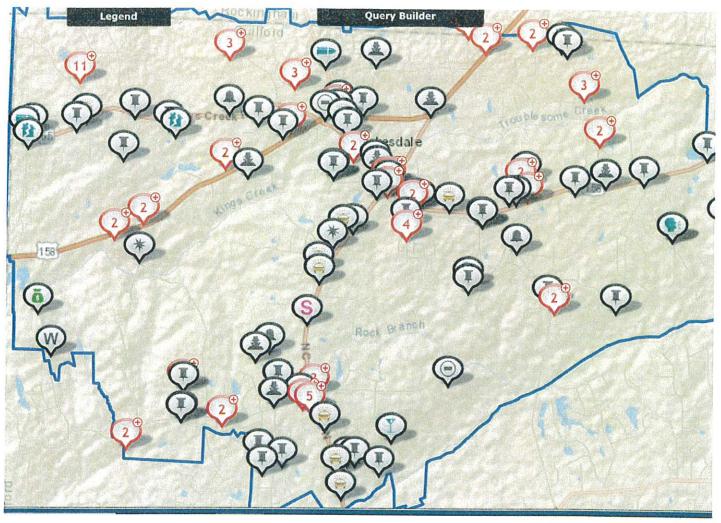

For the month of May, the sheriff's office responded to 179 calls in Stokesdale town limits, resulting in 10 reports.

### Of note:

- On 5/12, deputies responded to a homicide at 7876 Eversfield Road where they found 38-year-old Troy Scott Surface deceased from multiple gunshot wounds. On 5/13, John Austin Cain (18) was arrested and charged with first-degree murder in relation to the death of Surface. The investigation involved multiple divisions of the sheriff's office and the Rockingham County Sheriff's Office. (News release attached)
- On 5/14, deputies responded to an aggravated assault call in the 1800-block of Ellisboro Road in which a victim reported a road rage related incident in which another driver fired multiple rounds from a handgun. No injuries were reported nor was any property damaged. The offender was identified and warrants are still pending service on the individual involved.

# D.H. ROGERS, SHERIFF NEWS RELEASE May 14, 2024



Sheriff Danny H. Rogers reports that on May 12, 2024, at 5:04 p.m., the Guilford County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) responded to a homicide at 7876 Eversfield Road, Stokesdale, NC 27357. Upon arrival, Deputies located 38-year-old Troy Scott Surface suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Guilford County EMS and Fire Personnel responded to the scene and subsequently pronounced Mr. Surface deceased. This incident appears to be isolated, and there is no threat to the community.

On May 13, 2024, Detectives with the Guilford County Sheriff's Office and Rockingham County Sheriff's Office arrested 18-year-old John Austin Cain at a residence in Rockingham County. Cain was transported to the Guilford County Detention Center in Greensboro where he was charged with 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder. He is currently being held without a bond until his first court appearance on May 14, 2024. This investigation is ongoing, and no further information will be released at this time.

- The 2023 edition of the annual Consumer Confidence Report for the Town of Stokesdale has been uploaded to the Town of Stokesdale's website. Notifications and access instructions were printed on the back of all water bills in May.
- Water Line Extension Project (Coldwater Road)
  - This project is now advancing into the preliminary design phase, which encompasses geotechnical investigations and environmental assessments. To date, significant milestones, including survey completion and alignment selection, have been successfully achieved without any unforeseen challenges. ARPA grant funds have been allocated to support surveying and preliminary design activities. Hazen and Sawyer plan to initiate the bid phase in the third quarter of 2024 (July – September), ensuring that the funds are appropriately allocated by the deadline.
- Water Line Extension Project (Ellisboro Road)
  - Following the May 2024 Town Council Meeting, Town Clerk Wagoner contacted Kennerly Engineering with a list of comments regarding areas of the bid documents that needed revision. Once Kennerly Engineering incorporates these comments into the bid documents, they will distribute the updated documents to the vendors previously identified by the Town.

A Public Hearing will be held during the next regular Town of Stokesdale Planning Board meeting. This meeting will be held inside the Stokesdale Town Hall Council Chambers, located at 8325 Angel-Pardue Road, Stokesdale, North Carolina 27357 on Thursday, June 27, 2024, at 7:00 PM.

# PUBLIC HEARING ITEM:

A public hearing to consider adoption of the proposed Thoroughfare and Collectors Street Plan as prepared and adopted by the Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (GUAMPO) and subsequently amending the Town of Stokesdale's Future Land Use Plan.

The Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (GUAMPO) provides multi-modal transportation planning for the Town of Stokesdale among other communities in Guilford County, and the updated Thoroughfare and Street Collector Plan addresses the network of roadways that make up our communities, considers their function, ensures overall network stability, balances volume and access, and informs roadway design and speed limit. The Plan implements provisions of the Land Development Ordinance, establishes street design standards, manages access and connectivity, and secures rights-of-way as development occurs. This update is required to maintain consistency with the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan. Upon the potential adoption of the Plan and subsequent resolution, the Town of Stokesdale's Future Land Use Plan would be amended.

Notice of this public hearing has been submitted to the Greensboro News & Record and will be published in the newspaper's June 17, 2024, and June 24, 2024, editions. This publication complies with the requirements of the North Carolina Open Meetings Law.

The Stokesdale Town Staff are currently preparing the agenda packet for the upcoming meeting. Once finalized, this information will be promptly distributed to the members of the Stokesdale Planning Board and made available to the public.

# REZONING CASE 24-04-PLBD-00076, 7800 EVERSFIELD RD FROM AG (AGRICUTURAL) TO RS-40 (SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL)

## **Property Information**

Located on the east side of Eversfield Road (SR 2109), 1.02 miles north of the intersection of Eversfield Road with Oak Ridge Road, Guilford County Tax Parcel #150401, this is a request to rezone the subject property, which contains a total of 45.79 acres from AG (Agricultural) to RS-40 (Single-Family Residential). The Planning Board will make a recommendation to the Stokesdale Town Council, which will have the final authority to approve or deny the request.

Zoning History of Denied Cases: There is no history of denied cases for this parcel.

### Nature of the Request

### **District Descriptions:**

The AG, agricultural district, is primarily intended to accommodate uses of an agricultural nature, including farm residences and farm tenant housing. It also accommodates scattered non-farm residences on large tracts of land. It is not intended for major residential subdivisions. The district is established for the following purposes:

- 1) To preserve and encourage the continued use of land for agricultural, forest and open space purposes;
- 2) To discourage scattered commercial and industrial land uses;
- 3) To concentrate urban development in and around area growth centers, thereby avoiding premature conversion of farmland to urban uses;
- 4) To discourage any use which, because of its character, would create premature or extraordinary public infrastructure and service demands.

The **RS-40**, residential single-family district is primarily intended to accommodate single-family detached dwellings on large lots in areas without access to public water and wastewater services. The district is established to promote single-family detached residences where environmental features, public service capacities or soil characteristics necessitate very low-density single-family development. The overall gross density in RS-40 areas will typically be 1.0 unit per acre or less.

### **Character of the Area**

The parcel is surrounded by single-family residential and agricultural uses on all sides, with the Haw River providing a natural boundary from the Town of Summerfield to the south.

Existing Land Use(s) on the Property: This parcel is vacant.

Surrounding Uses:

North: Agricultural South: Single-Family Residential separated from this parcel by the Haw River East: Agricultural West: Single-Family Residential and Agricultural

Historic Properties: There are no designated historic landmarks located on or adjacent to the subject property.

**Cemeteries:** No cemeteries are shown to be located on or adjacent to this property, but efforts should be made to rule out the potential of unknown grave sites.

### Infrastructure and Community Facilities

### Emergency Response:

Fire Protection District: Stokesdale

Miles from Fire Station: Approximately 2.5 miles

### Water and Sewer Services:

Provider: Private Septic Systems and Wells

### Transportation:

Existing Conditions: Eversfield Road is a minor thoroughfare per the adopted Collector Street and Thoroughfare Plan.

Proposed Improvements: No improvements are proposed as part of this application.

Projected Traffic Generation: Unable to determine at this time since a final use has not been established. Eversfield Road carried 2,100 Average Annual Daily Trips (AADT) in 2022.

**School Impacts:** None are anticipated at this time. However, should the property develop as a residential subdivision, there could be minor impacts to the public school system.

### **Environmental Assessment**

Topography: Gently sloping and moderately sloping.

#### Regulated Floodplain/Wetlands:

There is a regulated 100-year floodplain (Special Flood Hazard Area) and floodway on the property, designated as flood zone AE by FEMA. There are mapped wetlands at the south and southeast sections of the property.

### Streams and Watershed:

There are mapped streams on the property. The property is not located in a designated Water Supply Watershed.

## Land Use Analysis

Land Use Plan: Stokesdale Land Use Plan (2007)

### Plan Recommendation: Residential:

Residential development makes up approximately 12% of the land area. The majority of this is low-density, single-family residents. One exception is the Countryside Village Retirement Community located on US 158. The majority of the residentially used and zoned property is located along the NC 68 corridor, in the Town Core Area, and along Athens Road and Southard Road. Major residential subdivisions have been added along Haw River Road, Ellison Road, Angel Pardue Road, and Belews Creek Road. Except in the town core, homes are on large lots that cover an acre or more. This is because there is no public sewer service available and significant area must be available for septic drain fields on each lot.

### Recommendation

### Staff Recommendation: Approve

## Statement of Reasonableness and Consistency

Reasonableness: This proposed rezoning action is reasonable and in the public interest because it is in an area where single-family residential uses are prevalent, and there would be no change in the minimum required lot size between the AG, Agricultural, zoning district and the RS-40, Single-Family Residential, zoning district.

Consistency: The request is consistent with the Stokesdale Future Land Use Plan designation of Residential; thus, if approved, a future land use plan amendment is not required.

#### 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Operating Budget Message

Mayor, Council Members and Members of the Public:

The Town of Stokesdale, North Carolina, situated in the northwest corner of Guilford County, is a charming rural community offering essential services including Planning and Zoning, Water, contracted Solid Waste/Recycling, and a Town Park. The Stokesdale Fire District and the Guilford County Sheriff's Department provide emergency services and police protection to the Town.

Stokesdale features a diverse mix of agricultural lands, businesses, industries, and residential areas. The local small business district caters to the needs of the residents, while several industries also operate within the town's boundaries. Encompassing 21.4 square miles, Stokesdale is intersected by three major highways, US Highway 158, NC Highway 68, and NC Highway 65, and partially borders Interstate 73. This extensive road network ensures that residents enjoy easy access to the nearby cities of Greensboro, High Point, and Winston-Salem.

Governed under the Mayor-Council form of government, the Town is led by a mayor and four council members who serve staggered 4-year terms.

The proposed operating budget for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year has been meticulously crafted based on input from budget workshops attended by council members and participating members of the public.

This budget adheres to the North Carolina Local Budget and Fiscal Control Act. The Town maintains a robust financial position, with reserves significantly exceeding state requirements, and continues to operate without imposing a town property tax. The proposed budget for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year is now presented for your review and consideration.

The Town acquires its water supply from the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Utilities Commission, with a connecting water line extending east along US Highway 158 from Forsyth County to the Town.

During the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year, the Town engaged diligently in negotiations with the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Utilities Commission, culminating in a significant agreement. This agreement increased the Town's water purchasing capacity by 66%, increasing the daily procurement allowance from 300,000 gallons to 500,000 gallons. Furthermore, the agreement extended the Town's water purchasing terms with the Commission by an additional 20 years, from 2030 to 2050. These strategic measures were undertaken to ensure an adequate and reliable water supply for the Town's residents and businesses.

For the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year, the Town will not levy ad valorem (property) taxes as a revenue source. In fact, the Town of Stokesdale remains the largest municipality within the state of North Carolina that does not levy ad valorem (property) taxes. The Town remains committed to providing long-standing services to its residents, including street lighting in the downtown area and a water system that supplies potable drinking water and supplemental water for the fire district.

In the 2002-2003 Fiscal Year, Guilford County distributed sales tax proceeds on a per capita basis, resulting in the Town receiving \$312,266. This distribution constituted a significant portion of the Town's fiscal revenue. However, during a meeting on June 20, 2002, the Guilford County Board of Commissioners resolved to change the distribution methodology from per capita to ad valorem (property tax), thereby eliminating the distribution of sales tax proceeds to the Town.

Since the onset of the Coronavirus pandemic, the Town of Stokesdale has adeptly navigated through unprecedented challenges. To mitigate revenue losses, the Town secured a federal grant totaling \$725,475.00 from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. A significant portion of these funds has been earmarked for vital enhancements to the Town Park, encompassing the construction of an outdoor basketball and pickleball court, installation of new playground equipment and amenities, engineering for athletic field lighting, refurbishment of picnic shelters, and procurement of a radar speed limit sign for US Highway 158 within the Town limits.

Furthermore, the Town has been awarded a substantial grant totaling \$3,113,038.00 from Guilford County, sourced from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. These funds are designated for enhancing the municipal water system, reinforcing the Town's infrastructure.

In addition, the Town has been awarded a grant of \$1,154,081.74 from the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management, allocated under North Carolina House Bill 1163. These funds will also be utilized to improve the municipal water system, ensuring its efficiency and reliability.

Moreover, the Town has been awarded a \$300,000.00 Asset Inventory and Assessment grant from the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, funded through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. These funds will facilitate the assessment and inventory creation of assets related to the Town's municipal water system, aiding in its management and maintenance.

Furthermore, the Town been awarded a \$100,000.00 Pre-Construction Planning grant from the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, sourced from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. These funds will support pre-construction planning activities related to the Town's municipal water system, ensuring effective project management and execution.

Additionally, the Town has secured a \$175,000.00 grant from the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management, allocated from the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year budget for the State of North Carolina. These funds will facilitate the construction and installation of athletic field lighting around the existing athletic fields at the Town Park, enhancing recreational facilities for residents.

Lastly, the Town received a \$50,000.00 Small Town Development Grant from the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management. This grant was fully utilized towards the construction of a new outdoor basketball and pickleball court at the Town Park, enriching recreational opportunities for the community.

The Town takes great pride in offering and maintaining a picturesque park for the enjoyment of all residents and visitors alike. Nestled behind the Town Hall building, the Town Park, known as "Martin's Meadow," serves as a verdant oasis within the community.

This sprawling park features a wealth of amenities, including a newly constructed outdoor basketball and pickleball court facility, two expansive athletic fields ideal for soccer enthusiasts, and two generously sized wooden picnic shelters equipped with metal seating, tables, and lighting, along with electrical hookups for added convenience.

Additionally, visitors can delight in a covered playground area and a newly installed uncovered playground, a sand volleyball court, a 0.73-mile paved walking trail, and a disc golf course. A concession stand is available, complemented by eight restroom facilities. Enhancing the park's natural beauty, a local boy scout troop is actively engaged in developing nature trails, while a girl scout troop is dedicated to establishing a vibrant pollinator garden, adding ecological diversity to the landscape.

Furthermore, the Town Park offers flexibility in its usage, with picnic shelters, athletic fields, and volleyball courts available for reservation at a nominal fee or accessible on a first-come-first-serve basis at no cost, ensuring equitable access for all members of the community to enjoy this enriching recreational space.

The Town operates with a limited staff structure, comprising a dedicated team including a full-time Town Clerk, a full-time Water System Customer Service Manager, a full-time Deputy Town Clerk, a part-time Deputy Town Clerk, a part-time Deputy Town Clerk, a part-time Certified Operator in Responsible Charge (ORC).

Since 2022, the Town has proudly been a participating member of the North Carolina Local Government Retirement System, ensuring the welfare of its employees. Additionally, the Town allocates funds for comprehensive health, dental, vision, and short-term disability insurance coverage for all eligible full-time staff members.

**TOWN OF STOKESDALE BUDGET:** The proposed combined General Fund and Water Enterprise Fund Operating Budget for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year totals \$6,144,652.45.

**GENERAL FUND REVENUES:** The General Fund Revenues for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year are estimated at \$912,197.48. The largest source of income, the State Collected Revenues, previously called Utilities Franchise Tax is estimated at \$295,00.00. The Beer & Wine Excise Tax is estimated at \$24,000.00. The Planning & Zoning Fees are estimated at \$12,000.00. The Solid Waste Disposal revenues are estimated at \$4,920.00. The Contributions & Donations revenues are estimated at \$3,500.00. The Town Hall & Park Facility Rental fees are estimated at \$3,000.00. The Greensboro-Jamestown ABC Profit Shares are estimated at \$1,000.00. The Investment Earnings are estimated at \$93,000.00. It is estimated that the interest rates on the Town's CDAR investments will range between 3.60% to 4.00%. The Town has \$300,277.48 remaining from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds which were received by the Town in 2021 and 2022. Also, the Town has received \$175,000.00 from the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management, allocated from the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year budget for the State of North Carolina. The transfer from the Undesignated Fund Balance is estimated to be \$0.00.

**REIMBURSEMENT TO GENERAL FUND:** The General Fund receives \$177,992.09 from the Water Enterprise Fund as reimbursement for shared expenses paid from the Town of Stokesdale General Fund.

**GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES:** The General Fund expenditures for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year are projected to be \$1,090,189.57. With the General Fund revenue estimated to

be at \$912,197.48 and with an allocation of 45.7% of costs to the Water Enterprise Fund amounting to \$177,992.09, which is reimbursed to the General Fund, a balanced budget is achieved for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year.

WATER ENTERPRISE FUND REVENUES: The proposed Operating Budget for the Water Enterprise Fund totals \$5,232,454.97. The Water Sales are estimated to be \$642,508.04. The System Development Fees (Capacity Fees) are estimated to be \$50,000.00. The Tap & Connection Fees are estimated to be \$20,000.00. The Late Fees are estimated to be \$1,000.00. The Damage Penalties & Meter Resetting Fees are estimated to be \$1,000.00. The Investment Earnings are estimated to be \$40,000.00. The awarded balance remaining of the grant provided to the Town by Guilford County, sourced from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds is \$2,957,461.24. The awarded balance remaining of the grant to the Town from the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management, allocated under North Carolina House Bill 1163 is \$1,120,485.69. The awarded balance remaining of the Asset Inventory and Assessment grant to the Town from the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, funded through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds is \$300,000.00. The awarded balance remaining of the Pre-Construction Planning grant to the Town from the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, sourced from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds is \$100,000. The transfer from the Undesignated Fund Balance is estimated to be \$0.00.

**WATER ENTERPRISE FUND EXPENDITURES:** Expenditures for the Water Enterprise Fund are estimated to be \$5,232,454.97. These expenditures include Direct Operational Expenses totaling \$704,508.04 and Capital Projects totaling \$4,527,946.93.

The Proposed Budget for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year is now available for review and feedback from both the Town Council and the public. This budget is designed to secure a robust financial standing for the Town, with revenue allocations intended to benefit all residents.

WHEREAS, N.C. General Statute § 153A-122, "Territorial jurisdiction of county ordinances," holds that county ordinances do not apply within towns unless the town, by resolution, permits the county ordinance to apply within the town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Stokesdale wishes to enter into an individual agreement with Guilford County, by which Guilford County has agreed to provide certain animal shelter and/or control services to the Town of Stokesdale, pursuant to the attached Interlocal Agreement, and doing so is in the public interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Council for the Town of Stokesdale does hereby ratify and authorize, in substantial form, the attached Interlocal Agreement between Guilford County and the Town of Stokesdale. The Stokesdale Town Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached Interlocal Agreement, in substantial form. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Guilford County Code, Chapter 5, "Animals," shall be effective within the Town of Stokesdale upon passage of this Resolution and execution of the attached Interlocal Agreement.

#### INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF STOKESDALE AND THE COUNTY OF GUILFORD FOR THE PROVISION OF ANIMAL SHELTER AND CONTROL SERVICES

This is an Interlocal cooperation agreement made and entered into this the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2024, by and between the Town of Stokesdale, a municipal corporation in the State of North Carolina (hereinafter called the "TOWN"), and Guilford County, North Carolina, a body politic and corporate (hereinafter called the "COUNTY").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the North Carolina General Statutes in Chapter 160A, Article 20, provide that units of local government may enter into agreements in order to execute an undertaking providing for the continual exercise by one unit of any power, function or right, including the provision of animal control and shelter services; and

WHEREAS, in 1955, the General Assembly authorized the COUNTY, the City of Greensboro, and the City of High Point to jointly construct and operate an animal shelter; and

WHEREAS, the TOWN and COUNTY agree that it was in the best interest of both parties that the COUNTY assume full financial responsibility for the animal shelter as initially agreed to on May 19, 2011 (Guilford County Contract No. 87960-04/11-022); and

WHEREAS, the TOWN and COUNTY agree that continued cooperation will result in more efficient administration and delivery of animal control services, and that as a result the public interest will be better served by this Agreement, as amended; and

WHEREAS, it is now desirable and in the mutual best interest of the TOWN and the COUNTY that both parties enter into a new agreement for the provision of animal control services and the operation of an animal shelter in accordance with the terms and conditions hereinafter set out.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants, terms and conditions contained herein accruing to the benefit of each of the respective parties hereto, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, it is hereby agreed as follows:

- 1. <u>Term of Agreement</u>. This Interlocal Agreement shall continue for two (2) years, from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026, unless terminated pursuant to the terms herein.
- 2. <u>Animal Shelter</u>. The TOWN and COUNTY agree that the COUNTY will maintain full financial responsibility for the operation of the Guilford County Animal Shelter, located at 980 Guilford College Road, Greensboro, North Carolina. Such responsibility includes all current and future capital expenditures related to the operation of the Guilford County Animal Shelter.
- 3. <u>Annual Payment to COUNTY</u>. For fiscal year 2024-2025, the TOWN will fund the provision of animal control services based on 1.1% of COUNTY's actual expenses for Animal Control services (within the meaning of Animal Control services under COUNTY's budget framework. Subject to this Agreement's provisions regarding termination, the COUNTY acknowledges that the TOWN may decide in the future to handle its own animal control functions. The annual payment is subject to future budget appropriations. Payments shall be due quarterly within thirty (30) days of invoice, which invoices shall follow the close of the July September, October December, January March, and April June quarters each year during which this agreement is in effect. Annual true-ups may be necessary in the following year if major mid-year action is required to enhance services. Invoices shall be based on actual expenses incurred during the previous quarter. For informational purposes, for fiscal year 2024-2025 services, the TOWN's estimated expense under this agreement is approximately **\$19.808.00**.
- 4. <u>Resolution</u>. In approving this Interlocal Agreement, the TOWN also adopts the Resolution attached as Exhibit A.
- 5. <u>Animal Control</u>.
  - a. The COUNTY agrees to enforce the animal control laws and ordinances of the COUNTY and TOWN within the corporate limits of the TOWN of Stokesdale.
  - b. The COUNTY agrees to humanely secure and protect animals found in violation of current animal control laws and to make every effort to safely return those animals to their owners.
  - c. The COUNTY agrees to promote responsible pet ownership through education, assistance and effective enforcement, thereby decreasing the number of euthanized animals and violations committed.
  - d. The COUNTY agrees to provide quality animal control service to the citizens of the TOWN of Stokesdale and meet their needs in a courteous, professional, efficient, productive and cost-effective manner.
  - e. The COUNTY agrees to provide adequate animal control positions for service delivery within the TOWN of Stokesdale limits.
  - f. The COUNTY agrees to operate animal control services within the corporate limits of the TOWN from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday. The COUNTY agrees to maintain adequate twenty-four (24) hour emergency services. The COUNTY agrees to establish protocol with law enforcement agencies for after hours use of animal control services.

- 6. <u>Reporting</u>. The COUNTY agrees to make available to the TOWN the following data on at least a quarterly basis:
  - a. A report on the number of calls requesting animal control services within the TOWN limits each month. Further information regarding specific instances can be provided, upon request.
  - b. The annual proposed and adopted COUNTY budget for animal control services.
  - c. The COUNTY and TOWN population numbers as determined by obtaining the most recent **certified** Census data from the State Demographics Branch of the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management.
- 7. Employees and Equipment. The TOWN and COUNTY agree that any employees or equipment transferred to the COUNTY under a prior agreement for animal control services are under the exclusive authority and ownership of the COUNTY. The COUNTY has the exclusive authority to appoint, remove and otherwise deal with any employees performing work under this Agreement. The COUNTY'S employees acting pursuant to this Agreement and within the scope of their authority or the course of their employment shall enjoy the jurisdiction, authority, rights, privileges and immunities including coverage under the workers' compensation laws which the officers, agents and employees of Guilford County enjoy within the COUNTY.
- 8. <u>Liability</u>. The COUNTY shall provide legal support and representation to its employees performing work under this agreement in accordance with COUNTY policies and resolutions concerning defense of employees. The COUNTY shall handle all claims arising out of its animal control services and its operation of the animal shelter. The COUNTY agrees that the TOWN shall have no responsibility or liability regarding any such claims. Nothing in this Agreement is intended, or shall be construed, to waive or prevent COUNTY from raising any immunity or defense that COUNTY, its officers, agents, and/or employees may have to such claims, all of which are reserved.
- 9. <u>Termination</u>. This Interlocal Agreement may be terminated by either party by providing twelve months notice prior to the start of the next fiscal year.
- 10. <u>Amendments</u>. This Agreement may be amended from time to time upon mutual consent of the governing bodies of the TOWN and COUNTY as expressed in writing.
- 11. <u>Prior Agreements</u>. This Interlocal Agreement supersedes any existing Interlocal Agreements between the TOWN and the COUNTY regarding the animal shelter and/or animal control services with respect to services provided on or after July 1, 2024.
- 12. In accordance with N.C.G.S. §143C-6A-5 and other applicable sections of N.C.G.S. §143C-6A regarding the Iran Divestment Act of 2015, each Party hereby certifies that it is not identified on the State Treasurer's list of persons which the Treasurer has determined engage in investment activities in Iran, including any subcontractors of either Party.

- 13. The PARTIES agree that this Agreement is subject to the jurisdiction and laws of the State of North Carolina, and both PARTIES agree to comply with all applicable laws. Any controversies arising out of this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of North Carolina.
- 14. <u>No Third-Party Beneficiaries</u>. There are no intended third-party beneficiaries of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Interlocal Agreement, as amended, in their respective names and titles, by their proper officials, all by the authority of appropriate resolutions of the governing bodies of each of the taxing units, duly adopted, as of the day and year first written above.

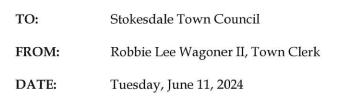

Dear Stokesdale Town Council,

As you all may be aware, the Town of Stokesdale currently pays Spectrum Enterprise \$821.41 per month for telephone, internet (25 Mbps), and television services.

In an effort to reduce this monthly expense, I have received multiple cost proposals from Julie Behenna with AT&T regarding telephone and internet services for the Stokesdale Town Hall building. Julie Behenna has provided the following options for AT&T services:
