Vote 2024—Information

The following is a Publishing Ballot for the 2024 General Election, to be held in Sweetwater County, Wyoming on November 5, 2024.

The name of the candidates will be rotated on the official ballots by precinct and will not necessarily appear in the order indicated on the Publishing Ballot. The official ballots will also have an oval next to each candidate's name. You may vote if you are:

- ◆ A citizen of the United States
- ◆ A resident of the State of Wyoming
- ◆ 18 years of age on Election Day
- ◆ Not a felon unless your civil rights have been restored
- ◆ Not currently adjudicated mentally incompetent
- ◆ You may register to vote at the polls on Election Day or when voting absentee.
- ◆ You must vote at the polling place for the precinct where you reside.

If you have a disability requiring assistance, you may vote absentee at the County Clerk's Office, at the polls using the ADA accessible touch screen, request an absentee ballot be mailed to you, or bring a person of your choice to the polls to assist you.

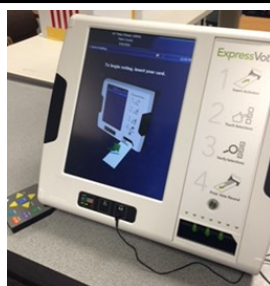
