DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Tucker, Georgia is currently experiencing an event of critical significance as a result of the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus; and

WHEREAS both the President of the United States and the Governor of the State of Georgia have declared national and state emergencies, respectively; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Mayor of the City of Tucker, there exist emergency circumstances located in the City requiring extraordinary and immediate corrective actions for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Tucker; and

WHEREAS, to prevent or minimize injury to people and damage to property resulting from this event;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by local and state law;


IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that a local state of emergency exists and shall continue until the conditions requiring this declaration are abated.


WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the applicable local emergency operations plan is hereby activated and City staff shall cooperate with the Centers for Disease Control, Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency and the DeKalb County Emergency Management Agency to combat the COVID-19 coronavirus and provide for the public welfare of the citizens of Tucker;

(2) The declaration of emergency shall be effective for 30 days, unless expressly extended or terminated.
