



# KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 1) Make sure you are registered to vote and your registration is up to date.
- 2) Be sure to have proper identification for in-person or absentee voting.
- 3) Mark your calendar to remember when early voting begins and ends.
- 4) Reminder! Voters can cast ballots at any advance voting location but must go to their assigned precinct on Election Day.

## What to bring with you for in-person voting:

- ✓ A valid ID, driver's license, passport, or voter identification card
- ✓ A mask to help ensure your safety and the safety of the poll workers and voters around you
- ✓ Your absentee ballot if you are wanting to vote in-person instead. If you do not have your absentee ballot, you will need to sign an affidavit stating that you are instead casting your ballot in-person

## Did you know?

On March 25, 2021, SB202 was signed into law and will change how some DeKalb voters are able to cast a ballot.

- ✓ Drop box locations are significantly reduced under the new law and will be available inside certain advance voting locations during operating hours only.
- ✓ DeKalb VRE offers FREE voter identifications. Call 404-298-4020 for more information.
- ✓ If voting by absentee ballot, a Georgia driver's license number, state identification number or last four digits of social security number is required.

## Forms of identification (ID) allowed under the new law include:

- Any valid state or federal government issued photo ID, including a free Voter ID card issued by your county registrar's office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS)
- A Georgia driver's license, even if expired
- A valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county, municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state
- A valid U.S. passport ID; a valid U.S. military photo ID or a valid tribal photo ID. Approved Voter Identification
