A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF UPPER MARLBORO TO APPROVE AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

**WHEREAS**, Chief David Burse was initially appointed to his position and thereafter an employment agreement was approved by a Board vote (2-0) at the November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018, Regular Board Work Session; and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Town Commissioners has reached a new agreement with David Burse to continue the terms of his employment under an updated or revised employment agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Town's Charter Section 82-16 (General Powers), the Town is authorized to establish, operate, and maintain a police force; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2-D of the Town's Personnel Systems Ordinance 2022-02, it provides guidance on the Board's approval of employment contracts thereby modifying the typical at-will employment relationship.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners for The Town of Upper Marlboro, sitting in regular session this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 2023, that the Town Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Town to enter into a 5-year employment contract with David Burse, to remain as Chief of Police for the Town of Upper Marlboro, in accordance with the agreement attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, and further authorizes the President to execute the relevant contract document on behalf of the Town.




