Founded in 1706, Upper Marlboro is the county seat of Prince George's County and the region's historical center of culture and entertainment. The Town has a rich history and maintains its closeknit, small town culture. In addition to the 632 residents, there are 23,000 people within 3 miles of the Town. With the County offices and County and District Courts, the daytime population swells to 7,632.
