Leaf Pickup Instruction:

Leaf pick up has started will continue thru November weather permitting. Please remember the following when utilizing our leaf pickup service:

- Place your leaves at the edge of the street.
- Do not place directly in the street or covering any storm drains/catch basins.
- Place leaves in a long narrow pile that extends across the width of your lot.
- Do not place any material other than leaves in the pile. This includes grass, walnuts, chestnuts, branches and any other type of yard material that may damage the leaf vacuum.
- Leaves will only be picked up once a day down your street. If you miss the pick up they will be picked up the next time the DPW workers are down your street.
- M-71 residents must call to schedule a pickup.

Leaves may still be taken to the compost lot located on W. Main St. (Compost Lot Resident Use Only) Your patience and understanding is appreciated.

Please Do Not Flush These Items Down the Toilet.

Leaves, Grass Clippings, and Snow on Streets

Depositing or blowing of these items on streets is prohibited and could lead to a misdemeanor citation

Snow and Ice Removal

Per the Village sidewalk ordinance, if there is a sidewalk on your lot or premises, you must clear the snow or ice from the sidewalk 24 hours after the cessation of any winter weather event. Sidewalks fronting on Main Street between Duane and Church Streets should be cleared of snow or ice by 10 a.m. and be maintained until 5 p.m. Please do not push snow into the roadway.



Parking

Parking in designated parking spots helps keep our streets clear during snow and ice events to allow the snow plow to clear the streets. Please be sure you are not parking on the roadway. Per our ordinance: No person shall park or leave standing any motor vehicle upon any major street in the Village from December 1 through the following March 31 between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
