The Scoop...

Yard Waste

Yard waste will be collected on an every other week basis from April until November each year on the regular trash collection day. All yard waste must be placed in biodegradable kraft paper bags or placed in 30 gallon cans, clearly marked as yard waste (Stickers are available in the Village Hall). Plastic bags will not be accepted. Branches and twigs smaller than 2" in diameter must be placed in bundles no larger than 2' x 4' long or 50 pounds per bag or bundle. No tree trunks, stumps, construction or demolition debris will be accepted.
