

ORDINANCE NO. 01-19

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VERNON VILLAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES AMENDING TITLE XI, BUSINESS REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 113, MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS REQUIRING A LICENSE

The Village of Vernon ordains:

Section 1. Title XI, *Business Regulations*, Chapter 113, *Miscellaneous Businesses Requiring a License of the Code of Ordinances*, Village of Vernon, is hereby amended to add a new Section 113.30, entitled *Prohibition of Marijuana Establishments*, to read as follows:

113.30 PROHIBITION OF MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS


(A) Pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act, Section 6.1, the Village elects to prohibit marijuana establishments within its boundaries, including, but not limited, any marijuana grower, marijuana safety compliance facility, marijuana processor, marijuana microbusiness, marijuana retailer, marijuana secure transporter, or any other type of marijuana-related business licensed by the State of Michigan under the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act.

(B) Pursuant to the Michigan Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act, Section 205(1), being MCL 333.27205(1), the Village elects to prohibit medical marijuana facilities within its boundaries, including, but not limited, any medical marijuana grower, medical marijuana processor, medical marijuana provisioning center, medical marijuana transporter, medical marijuana safety compliance facility, or any other type of medical marijuana-related business licensed by the State of Michigan under the Michigan Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act.

Section 2. Savings Clause. This Ordinance shall in no manner affect pending litigation, either civil or criminal, founded or growing out of any ordinance, resolution, order or parts thereof, hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall in no manner affect any rights, claims, privileges, immunities or causes of action of the Village, County or other person, either criminal or civil, that may have already occurred, accrued or grown out of any ordinance, resolution, order or policy, or any part thereof, hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall in no manner affect pending litigation, either civil or criminal, founded or growing out of any ordinance, resolution, order parts thereof, hereby repealed.

Section 3. Validity and Severability. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found invalid for any reason, such a holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of its publication.
