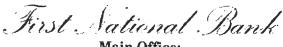

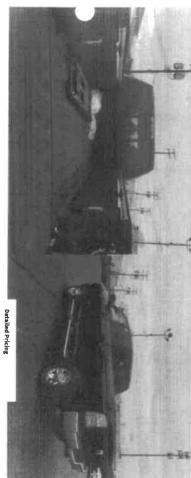
I'd like to thank Dennis Hendrickson for extending this opportunity to me and for being a voice of reason and diplomacy.

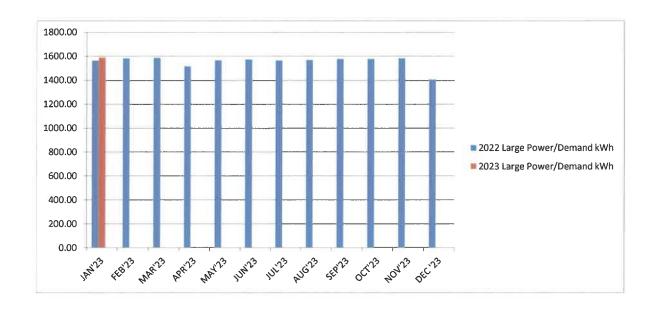

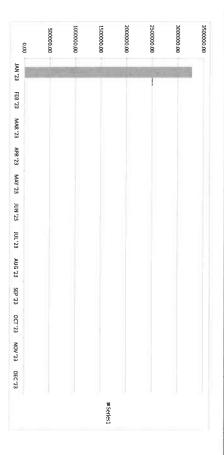

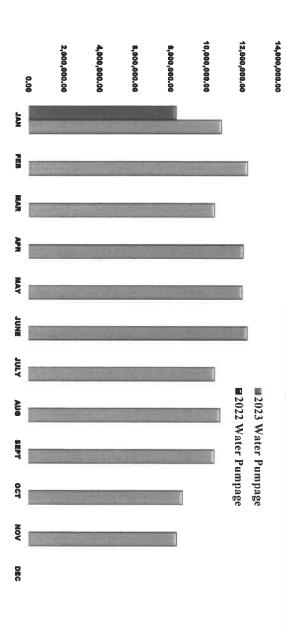
