

Instructions for Completing a Stormwater Utility Exemption Application

1. Complete the top half of the form, including the applicant's name, property owner's name (if different), physical address, and the parcel number. If you do not know your parcel number, please include the statement number from the top of your stormwater utility bill.
2. Check one box in the yellow area titled, "Exemption Requested". For most people the box that applies will be the last one; "No Discharge to County Facilities or Surface Water".
3. Sign and date the application. Supporting data (including photos, letters explaining why the property should be exempt, or any other information) is not required for residential or farm parcels, but may be helpful.

Commercial, industrial, or other non-residential or agricultural parcels may be asked to submit substantiating data from a licensed engineer.

4. Briefly, applications are approved for exemption if they meet any one of the following:
 - Parcel does not abut a County road.
 - Parcel is at a lower elevation than the adjacent County road with no discharge to the County road right of way (including ditches and shoulders). Driveway must slope away from the County road right of way.
 - Parcel is at the same or greater elevation than the County road, but does not discharge to the County road right of way, with a driveway that slopes away from the County road. It must be evident that stormwater from the developed portions of the parcel (including the driveway) will not reach the County road right of way.
 - Certification by a licensed engineer that all stormwater is retained onsite.

A technician will drive by the property and visually assess the potential for stormwater impacts. No one will need to come onto your property. You will receive a written decision in the mail.
