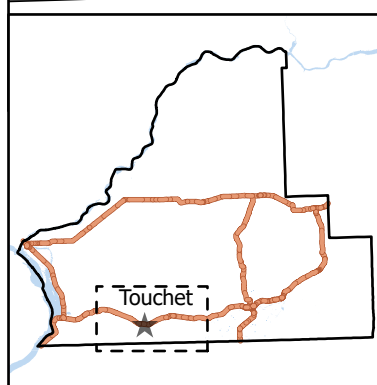
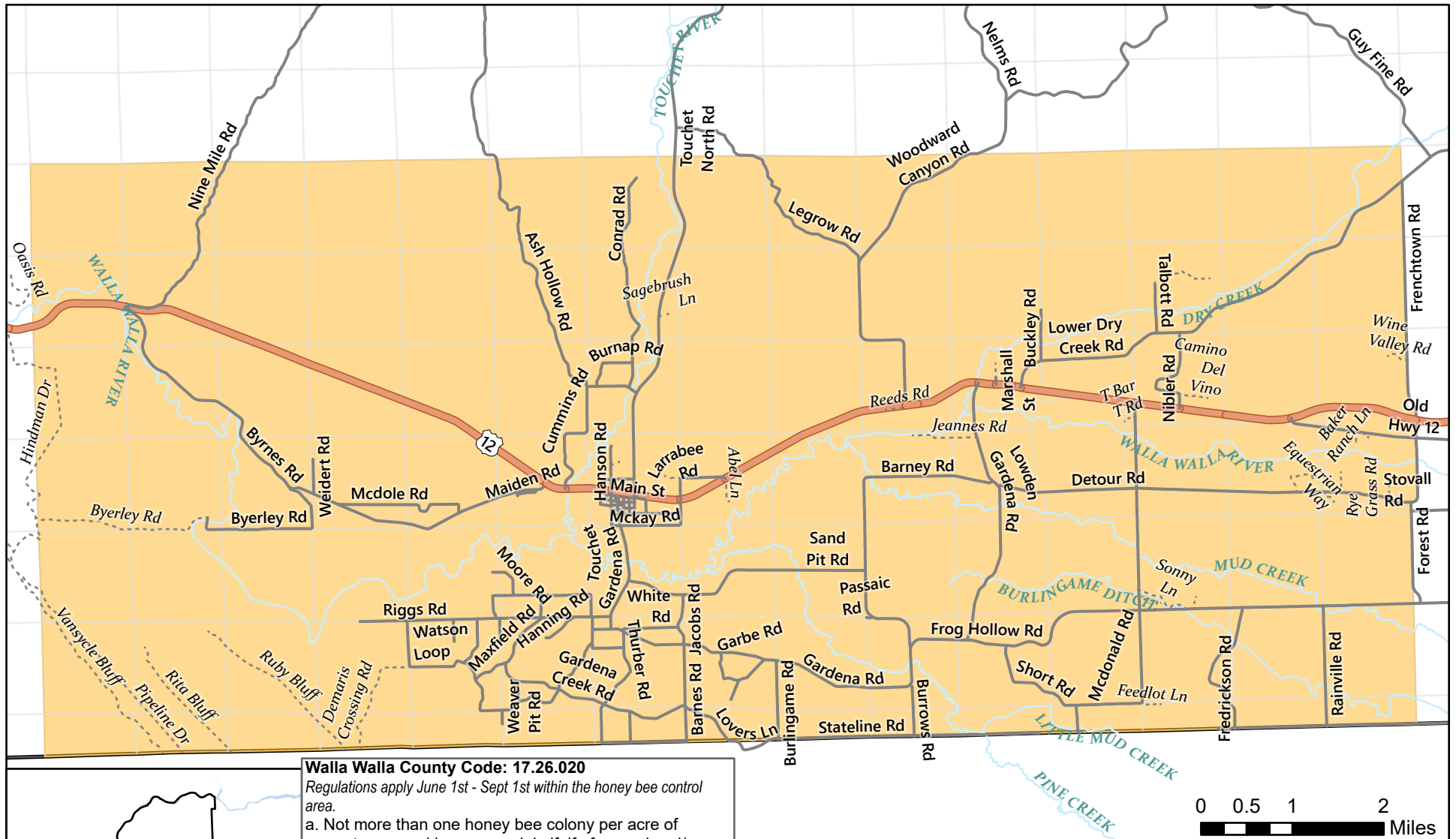




Walla Walla County Honey Bee Control Area



Walla Walla County Code: 17.26.020

Regulations apply June 1st - Sept 1st within the honey bee control area.

- Not more than one honey bee colony per acre of property cropped in commercial alfalfa for seed and/or commercial clover for seed that is blossoming is permitted.
- Not more than $\frac{1}{4}$ honey bee colony per acre of property with blossoming bee forage of other types is permitted.
- Not more than 50 colonies are permitted in an apiary.
- Apiaries must be setback from property lines a distance of four feet per colony.
- Apiaries must be separated a distance of 400 feet and must be located within 400 feet of blossoms intended as forage.
