

Ordinance No. 3

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF AMUSEMENT CARNIVALS.

Passed by the Board of County Commissioners March 17, 1941.
Book "N" page 266.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington, under and by virtue of the authority in them vested by Article Eleven, Section Eleven, of the Constitution of the State of Washington, as follows:

Section 1. LICENSE REQUIRED - It Shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association, society or corporation to sponsor, permit or conduct an amusement carnival in the County of Walla Walla, Washington, and without the limits of incorporated cities or towns therein without first obtaining a license so to do as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. LICENSE FEE - The license fee for sponsoring or conducting a carnival shall be \$5.00.

Section 3. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE - Application for license hereunder shall be made in writing, filed with the Board of County Commissioners, and shall be accompanied by a deposit of the amount of the license fee which said sum shall be returned in the event the said license is not granted and shall state the location of the place where the applicant or applicants shall conduct such carnival, and shall state that said applicant will comply with all of the rules and regulations of Walla Walla County or the State of Washington.

Section 4. GRANTING OF LICENSE. The Board of County Commissioners, after said application has been made, may in its discretion grant said license, or in its discretion for any cause deemed sufficient, may refuse to grant any license or permit whatsoever for a carnival.

Section 5. LICENSE NOT TRANSFERABLE. No license shall be assigned or transferred except by written permission of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 6. DEPUTY SHERIFF REQUIRED. The Board of County Commissioners in their discretion may require the applicant for said license to hire at his own expense a Deputy Sheriff of Walla Walla County, Washington, to be appointed by the Sheriff of Walla Walla County, Washington, to attend such carnival, and the applicant's failure to do so will be deemed a violation of this ~~ordinance~~ ordinance.

Section 7. REVOCATION OF LICENSE. Any license or license of whatsoever kind granted hereunder may be revoked by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington, for any violation of the provisions of this ordinance or any state or federal law.

Section 8. PENALTIES. Any person violating any of the pro-

visions of this ordinance or resolution shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$250.00 or imprisoned for a term not exceeding ninety days in the County Jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
