AN ORDINANCE AND RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE WALLA WALLA CITY-COUNTY AIRPORT AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

The City of Walla Walla does ordain and the County of Walla Walla does resolve;

Section 1. In order to make this Ordinance and resolution relating to the operation of motor vehicles within the Walla Walla City-County Airport uniform with the laws of the State of Washington, all of the provisions of the Washington Motor Vehicle Act (being Chapter 189 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1927) as amended or as hereafter may be amended; all of the provisions of the Washington Highway License Act (being Chapter 189 of Laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they hereafter may be amended; and all the provisions of the Washington State Highway Act (being Chapter 53 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they hereafter may be amended; are hereby adopted by the City and County of Walla Walla and are by reference made a part of this Ordinance and Resolution.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the terms of the laws referred to in Section 1 of this Ordinance and Resolution within the limits of the Walla Walla City-County Airport shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance and Resolution.

Section 3. On days of celebrations, holidays, and special occasions which tend to increase traffic, the Airport Board or a suitable person appointed by it for the purpose, shall have power and authority to establish by appropriate signs or enclosures, districts wherein no parking of any vehicles shall be allowed. On streets where building operations are being carried on; and for the public safety when traffic is congested, the Airport Board or a suitable person designated by it may temporarily close any street or portion of a street to all vehicle traffic.

Section 4. The Airport Board shall have full power and authority to designate portions of any street within said Walla Walla City-County Airport which shall not be used for parking purposes. When any portion of any street is so designated it shall be appropriately marked or posted. It shall be unlawful for any person to leave or park any motor vehicle or other vehicle within any portion of any street so marked or posted. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle on any streets within the Walla Walla City-County Airport where standard signs have been or hereafter may be erected and maintained prohibiting parking.

Section 5: The Airport Board shall have full power and authority to designate the location of any traffic signs or standards within the limits of said Walla Walla City-County Airport.

Section 6: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to draw, propell along, over or across any of the paved streets in the Walla Walla City-County Airport, any traction engine, tractor, threshing machine, combine harvester or other vehicle having on the tractive surfaces of its vehicle any spikes, cleats or flanges, unless such person, firm or corporation

shall have first obtained a permit therefor from the Airport Manager.

Section 7: No vehicle shall overtake or pass or attempt to pass another vehicle going in the same direction at a highway intersection or at a highway "T" intersection except by direction of a traffic officer.

Section 8: The Airport Manager shall be a police officer for all purposes of enforcing all traffic ordinances and regulations at the Walla Walla City-County Airport.

Section 9: It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of the following:

(a) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour within the limits of the Walla Walla City-County Airport; (b) Twenty (20) miles in traversing any intersection of public highways within the limits of said Airport where the operator's view is obstructed. An operator's view shall be deemed to be obstructed when at any time during the last 100 feet of his approach to an intersection he does not have the clear and uninterrupted view of such intersection and of all public highways entering such intersection for a distance of 100 feet along the center line of each thereof; (c) Twenty (20) miles per hour while traveling upon portion of any public highway of said Walla Walla City-County Airport when such portion of the highway is so sign-posted at the extremities thereof.

Section 10: The Airport Board shall have the power to pass any rule or regulation requiring a different rate of speed than that specified hereunder and which vehicles may be operated along or over the highways within the limits of said Airport or otherwise to regulate the use of the public highways thereof in the same manner as any governing body or authority of any City or Town or political sub-division now has or shall hereafter have under the laws of the State of Washington.

Section ll: Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance and Resolution or who shall counsel, aid or abet any such violation or failure to comply shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition to the above penalties, the Justice of the Peace for Walla Walla Precinct, Walla Walla County, Washington, shall full power and authority, in accordance with the laws mentioned in Section 1 of this Ordinance and Resolution, to suspend, revote, or cancel the motor vehicle operator's license of any person convicted in said Justice Court of negligent driving, reckless driving or driving or operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

Section 12: If any of the provisions of this Ordinance are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 13: This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall be in effect immediately upon
