

ORDINANCE

RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON ALL COUNTY ROADS IN THE TOWNSITE OF BURBANK, INCLUDING ADDITIONS THERETO, AND IN THE VICINITY OF COUNTY SCHOOLS AT BURBANK, OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION HEREOF.

The County of Walla Walla does hereby resolve:

Section 1. In order to make this resolution relating to the operation of motor vehicles on certain county roads in the vicinity of Walla Walla County Schools uniform with the laws of the State of Washington, all of the provisions of the Washington Motor Vehicle Act (being Chapter 189 of the laws of Washington for the year 1927) as amended or as hereafter may be amended; all of the provisions of the Washington Highway License Act (being Chapter 189 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they hereafter may be amended; and all of the provisions of the Washington State Highway Act (being Chapter 53 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they hereafter may be amended; are hereby adopted by the County of Walla Walla and are by reference made a part of this resolution.

Section 2. Any person violating any terms of the laws referred to in Section 1 of this resolution within the bounds to be hereafter mentioned shall be guilty of a violation of this resolution.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of the following: twenty-five (25) miles per hour on any of the county roads hereafter mentioned:

All streets in and around the boundaries of the original townsite of Burbank excepting those streets closed by the relocation of the Northern Pacific railway Company and also all streets in and around the boundaries of North Addition and Butt's Addition to the said townsite of Burbank and also one thousand (1000') feet of a County Road known as the Hassey Road extending easterly from the easterly limits of the said townsite of Burbank.

Section 4. The above speed zone has been hereby created in order to properly protect the children of the Town of Burbank, School District 400, being a legally established County School District of Walla Walla County.

Section 5. It is hereby further resolved that the County may further decrease the speed zone within five hundred feet (500') on all of the above-mentioned streets immediately adjoining said school grounds. Said speed within the immediate area of the school buildings to be established at twenty miles per hour (20 m.p.h.) on County streets in said area.

Section 6. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this resolution or who shall counsel, aid or abet any such violation or failure to comply shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition to the above penalties, the Justice of the Peace for Burbank, Walla Walla County, Washington, shall have full power and authority, in accordance with the laws mentioned in Section 1 of this resolution, to suspend,

revoke, or cancel the motor vehicle operator's license of any person convicted in said Justice Court of negligent driving, reckless driving or driving or operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

Section 7. If any of the proposed provisions of this resolution are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the resolution shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 8. This resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and legal publication
