

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SPRINKLING UPON OR SUFFERING AND PERMITTING ACCUMULATION OF IRRIGATION WASTE WATER ON OR ALONG COUNTY ROADS IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington as follows:

SECTION I. No Person, firm or corporation, shall suffer or permit any irrigation waste water to accumulate or encroach upon the traveled portion of any county road within Walla Walla County.

SECTION II. No person, firm or corporation shall suffer, permit or engage in any irrigation activities that will result in irrigation water, waste or otherwise, being permitted to fall upon, run upon, run across, or accumulate upon any county road right-of-way in Walla Walla County, Washington.

SECTION III. Any person guilty of the violation of this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by not more than 30 days in the county jail for each separate offense as well as responding in damages to Walla Walla County, Washington, for any reasonable amount necessary to repair, replace, resurface or to otherwise restore such county road as may be effected to the condition in which the same was before the act complained of took place.
