

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF WALLA WALLA:

Section 1: That this ordinance is necessary for the sanitary protection of the water supply of the City of Walla Walla.

Section 2: That no person shall enter or be upon that part of the land comprising the City of Walla Walla Water Shed lying in the County of Walla Walla, State of Washington, unless he first shall have obtained and have upon his person written permission signed by an authorized representative of the United States Forest Service of the Department of Agriculture.

Section 3: That a description of the City of Walla Walla Water Shed is annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 4: That any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not more than thirty days.

Boundary Route for the Walla Walla Water Department Mill Creek
Water Shed Area

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of Section 22, Township 6 North, Range 38, East of the Willamette Meridian, said point also being the South west corner of the Walla Walla Water Department land, and run thence in a Northeasterly direction to the intersection of Mill Creek with the Intake Ridge Trail; thence in a Northeasterly direction, following said Intake Ridge Trail to the Stewart Cabin Road; thence in a Northerly and an Easterly direction, following along said Stewart Cabin Road, passing Stewart's Cabin to the aforesaid Intake Ridge Trail; thence in a Northeasterly direction following along said Intake Ridge Trail to the West line of Section 30, Township 7 North, Range 39, East of the Willamette Meridian; thence in a Southeasterly, Northerly, and Easterly direction, following along said Intake Ridge Trail, passing through Green Peak and Deadman Peak, to the Skyline Road, thence in a Southerly direction, following along said Skyline Road to the Table Rock Lookout Trail; thence in a Southerly Direction, following said Table Rock Lookout Trail, passing through Table Rock to the aforesaid Skyline Road; thence in a Southerly direction, following along said Skyline Road to the Water Shed Boundary Trail; thence in a Southwesterly direction, following along said Water Shed Boundary Trail to aforesaid Skyline Road; thence in a Southwesterly direction, following the Skyline Road, which follows the afroesaid Water Shed Boundary Trail and continuing Southwesterly where the

Water Shed Boundary Trail leaves the Skyline Road, to the Big Meadow Road at Deduck Spring; thence in a Southwesterly direction, following along said Big Meadow Road to the Indian Ridge Trail in Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 39, East of the Willamette Meridian; thence in a Westerly and a Northwesterly direction, following along said Indian Ridge Trail to a point due South of the point of beginning; thence North, in a straight line, to the point of beginning
