

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDENANCE REGULATING THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington:

Section 1. The Regulation of the hours of public swimming pools outside of incorporated cities and towns in Walla Walla County, Washington, is hereby declared necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and morals of the people of this County.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to operate public swimming pools, accept admission charges to the same, permit swimming therein, or operate loud speaker devices in connection therewith, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. of any day except Saturday, and 12:00 mid-night on Saturdays, and 6:00 a.m. of the next day following.

Section 3. Any violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days or a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or both. Each separate day on which this Ordinance is violated shall constitute a separate offense.
