

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT ON PORTIONS OF COLLEGE PLACE HIGHWAY AND WALLULA AVENUE IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON,  
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful to operate any motor vehicle upon the hereinafter described County roads at any speed in excess of 35 m.p.h. Said County roads are as follows:

That portion of College Place Highway (Old State Highway No. 3) between the westerly city limits of the City of Walla Walla and the easterly city limits of the town of College Place, all in Walla Walla County, Washington.

That portion of County road No. 195 (Wallula Avenue) between its intersection with College Place Highway and a point on said County road No. 195 (Wallula Avenue) 227.91 feet west of the center line of Campbell Street, said point also being 1327.09 feet east of the west line of Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 35 EWM, in Walla Walla County, Washington.

SECTION 2: Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.
