

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS KNOWN AS THREE MILE BRIDGE ROAD AND TAUSICK WAY.

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to park or stop any vehicle at any time on that portion of Three Mile Bridge Road and Tausick Way, being County Roads within Walla Walla County, Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land for road purposes, 60 feet in width being 30 feet on each side of the following described center-line.

Beginning at a point which is the section corner of sections 15, 14, 22 and 23 in Township 7 North, Range 36 East of the Willamette Meridian and running thence South  $0^{\circ} 18'$  East along the line between section 22 and 23 to a point 21.9 feet south of the south end of the Three Mile Bridge across Mill Creek, this described strip being a portion of a County Road known as the Three Mile Bridge Road, the above mentioned point being the junction of the said Three Mile Bridge Road and Tausick Way; thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 716.3 feet, a distance of 524.3 feet; thence on a course tangent to the aforementioned curve South  $41^{\circ} 38' 30''$  West a distance of 178.8 feet more or less to a point being Engineer's Station 7+25.0 in the center-line of the aforesaid Tausick Way in Section 22 Township 7 North, Range 36 E.W.M.

The total length of said described strip being 1,395.8 feet more or less.

Section 2. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00.
