

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE HARSHA ROAD IN SECTION 6, T.9 N., R.35 E.W.M. FROM A POINT 1,000 FEET NORTHERLY OF THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY'S OVERPASS TO A POINT 1,000 FEET SOUTHERLY FROM SAID OVERPASS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. In order to make this Ordinance relating to the operation of motor vehicles on the Harsha Road in the vicinity of its intersection with SSH-3D in Walla Walla County uniform with the provisions of the Washington Motor Vehicle Act (Being Chapter 189 of the laws of Washington for the year 1927) as amended or as hereafter may be amended: all of the provisions of the Washington Highway License Act (being Chapter 189 of the laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they may hereafter be amended; and all of the provisions of the Washington State Highway Act (being Chapter 53 of the laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they hereafter may be amended: are hereby adopted by the County of Walla Walla and are by reference made a part of this Ordinance. (Done in accordance with Chapter 27 of the Session Laws of 1961.)

Section 2. Any person violating any terms of the laws referred to in Section 1 of this Ordinance within the bounds to be hereafter mentioned shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of the following: Twenty five (25) miles per hour as posted by the County Engineer on any of the County roads hereafter mentioned:

That part of the Harsha Road near its intersection with SSH-3D from a point 1,000 feet northerly of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's overpass to a point 1,000 feet southerly from said overpass.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance or who shall counsel, aid or abet any such violation or failure to comply shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. If any of the proposed provisions of this Ordinance are held invalid or unconstitutional the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall become null and void upon the completion and acceptance of Federal Aid Project S-1077(3) with the Washington State Highway Commission.
