

ORDINANCE NO. 86

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CONTROL OF PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. In order to make this Resolution relating to the control of parking of motor vehicles on certain county roads where properly posted for controlled NO PARKING uniform with the provisions of the Washington Motor Vehicle Laws, Laws of Washington, as amended, or as hereinafter may be amended, they are by reference made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Any person violating any terms of the laws referred to in Section 1. of this Resolution within the bounds to be hereafter mentioned shall be guilty of a violation of this Resolution.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same by parking it in areas posted with official signs prohibiting stopping or parking as listed below:

- A (1) The County Engineer is hereby authorized to designate and determine where to erect signs indicating NO PARKING upon that side of any road adjacent to any school property when such parking would, in his opinion, interfere with traffic or create a hazardous situation.
- (2) When official signs are erected indicating NO PARKING upon that side of a street adjacent to any school property, no person shall park a vehicle in any such designated place.
- B (1) The County Engineer is hereby authorized to determine and designate by proper signs, places along any Walla Walla County road in which stopping, standing or parking of vehicles would create an especially hazardous condition or would cause unusual delay to traffic.
- (2) When official signs are erected at hazardous or congested places as authorized herein, no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle in such designated places.
- C The provisions or signs imposing a time limit on parking shall not relieve any person from the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles in specified places or at specified times.
- D PARKING SIGNS REQUIRED - Whenever this ordinance or any other ordinance of this Walla Walla County concerning parking or no parking is imposed or parking is prohibited, it shall be the duty of the County Engineer to erect appropriate signs and no such regulations shall be effective unless signs are erected and in place at the time of any alleged offense.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Resolution or who shall counsel, aid or abet any such violation or fail to comply shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 5. If any of the proposed provisions of this Resolution are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Resolution shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. This Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage.
