AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE USE OF ANY MOTOR DRIVEN VEHICLE UPON THE MILL CREEK RECREATION TRAIL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any unauthorized person to ride a motor bike, motorcycle or other motor driven vehicle upon Mill Creek Recreation Trail within the limits of Walla Walla County.

Section 2. The term "Mill Creek Recreation Trail" as used herein means that trail traversing a portion of property owned by the County of Walla Walla beginning at the eastern city limits of the City of Walla Walla, County of Walla Walla, State of Washington, and running easterly, along said north bank of Mill Creek to Rooks Park in the County of Walla Walla, State of Washington, a distance of 0.95 miles, more or less.

Section 3. Any person violating any terms of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
