

## ORDINANCE NO. 92

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FILING OF RECORD OF SURVEYS AND MONUMENTS  
AND THE FEES TO BE CHARGES THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County,  
Washington as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to implement the Survey Recording Act (Chapter 50, Laws of 1973) and to assist in preserving evidence of land surveys by establishing fees for recording a public record as prescribed by the act.

SECTION 2. RECORD OF SURVEY. The record of land surveys shall be on a size sheet acceptable to the County Auditor, but no larger than 18 inches by 24 inches and filed according to the following fee schedule:

SECTION 3. COPIES. Copies of the record of survey shall be provided on request according to the following fee schedule:

SECTION 4. RECORD OF MONUMENT. The Record of Monument shall be filed without charge on the standard form prescribed by the Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of Surveys and Maps.

SECTION 5. COPIES. Copies of the Record of Monument shall be provided on request according to the following fee schedule:
