ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SWIMMING AND TRESPASSING IN CERTAIN AREAS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY BETWEEN CERTAIN TIMES AND DATES AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION I. No person shall swim, wade or enter into that portion of the Columbia River known as Quarry Pond, which is more particularly described below, for those months of each year commencing June 1 through October 1, to-wit:

Quarry Pond, located approximately three miles south of Burbank, west of Highway 395, within Lots 20, 21, 28 and 29 in Township 8, Range 31, within Walla Walla County, State of Washington.

SECTION II. Be it further ordained that no person shall trespass upon said Quarry Pond or that area surrounding said Quarry Pond and more particularly described above, during the hours of 8:00 P.M. to 8:00 A.M., and that said area shall be closed during said times to the public.

SECTION III. This Ordinance is being enacted under the Police power of this Board to protect the safety of persons and properties in the above area.

SECTION IV. Any person guilty of a violation of this Ordinance may be punished by fine of not more than \$100.00 or by not more than 30 days in the county jail, or both, for each separate offense.

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall take effect the 1st day of July, 1974.
