

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FILING OF RECORD OF SHORT PLATS AND SHORT SUBDIVISIONS AND THE FEES TO BE CHARGED THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE The purpose of this ordinance is to implement R.C.W. 58.17.065 (1974 1st. Extra Session) which requires that each short plat and short subdivision granted pursuant to local regulations after July 1, 1974 shall be filed with the County Auditor and shall not be deemed "approved" until so filed.

SECTION 2. RECORD The record of short plat or short subdivision shall be on a sheet size 18 inches by 24 inches, of durable material to insure permanence, such as plastic (Mylar) or hard paper plat sheets, and filed according to the following fee schedule:

- A. Basic fee - first page \$10.00
- B. Each additional page 5.00
