

PARKING ORDINANCE FOR COUNTY)
PARKING LOTS)

NO. 147

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION I: Parking of vehicles in a county parking lot at the county courthouse and county annex buildings, shall be limited to employees of the county and patrons of county offices, and patron parking shall be limited to a period of two (2) consecutive hours.

The custodian of the Walla Walla County Maintenance Department, and/or the Sheriff of Walla Walla County, is authorized and directed to erect appropriate signs for parking of employee's automobiles on the county parking lots and further, indicating the time limitation of two (2) hours parking for patrons of county offices.

The custodian of the Walla Walla County Maintenance Department, and/or the Sheriff of Walla Walla County, is authorized to enforce the two (2) hour time limitation on parking in the county parking lots and is given the authority to impound or cause to be impounded any vehicles which violates the provisions hereof at the expense of the owner of the vehicle or vehicles impounded.

SECTION II: Parking of vehicles in the parking lots at the Southeastern Washington Fair grounds, including the overflow parking area at Garrison Junior High School, shall be limited to patrons of the fairgrounds, and during the Southeastern Washington Fair, and other public events, parking shall be limited to the patrons of these events and employees of the Southeastern Washington Fair grounds.

The Manager of the fairgrounds is authorized to erect appropriate

signs indicating the use of the Southeastern Washington Fair grounds and further, indicating the limitation on the use of the fairgrounds during the Southeastern Washington Fair and other public events held at the fairgrounds.

The Manager, and/or Sheriff of Walla Walla County, is authorized and directed to enforce the parking limitation at the Southeastern Washington Fair ground parking lots, and is hereby given the authority to impound, or cause to be impounded, any vehicle which violates the provisions hereof at the expense of the owner of the vehicle or vehicles impounded.

SECTION III: Vehicles parked in violation of no parking signs or parked in areas designated for the travel of vehicles or blocking other vehicles in parking lots referred to in Sections I and II, may be removed and impounded at the expense of the owner of the vehicle impounded.

SECTION IV: Jurors may park longer at the Walla Walla County Courthouse parking lot during jury duty upon the display of a proper parking permit in the front window of the vehicle.

SECTION V: This Ordinance shall take effect the 21st day of August, 1979.

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 147 OF THE COUNTY OF WALLA WALLA
ADDING TO SECTION I. TO DESIGNATE EACH SPECIFIC LOT AND REGULATIONS PER-
TAINING TO EACH LOT FOR PURPOSES OF ENFORCEMENT.

SECTION I. OF ORDINANCE NO. 147 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. (AMENDED): Parking of vehicles in the following County
Parking Lots shall be limited as follows:

1. County Courthouse Parking - South side of parking lot limited
Lot between 4th & 5th to employees of the County. North
Streets and Alder Street side open to public on a two (2)
Alley. hour limit. All of this will be
posted as a tow-away zone for fail-
ure to comply with above limitations.
2. Courthouse Parking Lot on - Lot is limited to parking by patrons
Southeast Corner of Main of the County Services. This lot will
and 5th Streets. be posted as a tow-away zone for in-
fraction of the two(2) hour limit.
3. County Service Building - Lot is open to patrons of the County
Parking North Side of Engineers and County Extension Offices.
Building off the Alley.
Five stalls maximum.
4. County Health Building - County Employees and patrons of the
and Justice Court Build- County Health Department and District
ing Annex Parking Lot on Court.
North Side of Buildings
to Alley.
5. County Parking West Side - County Employees and patrons to
of 5th Street between County Health Services.
Alder Street and Alley.

County Employee's vehicles will be allowed to park in any County Park-
ing Lot during working hours by displaying a decal issued by the custodian of
Walla Walla County Maintenance Department.

The Custodian of Walla Walla County Maintenance Department, and/or
the Sheriff of Walla Walla County, is authorized and directed to erect approp-
riate signs for parking of employee's automobiles on the County Parking Lots
and further indicating the time limitation of two(2)hours parking for patrons
of County Offices.

The Custodian of the Walla Walla County Maintenance Department, and/
or the Sheriff of Walla Walla County, is authorized to enforce the two (2) hour
time limitation on parking in the County Parking Lots and given the authority to
impound or cause to be impounded any vehicles which violates the provisions here-
of at the expense of the owner of the vehicle or vehicles impounded.

PROPOSED PARKING OR- DINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
BOARD of County Com-
missioners of Walla Walla
County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION I. Parking of
vehicles in a county parking lot
at the County Courthouse and
County Annex Buildings shall be
limited to employees of the
County and patrons of County
offices, and patron parking shall
be limited to a period of two (2)

The custodian of the Walla

the expense of the owner of the
vehicle or vehicles impounded.

SECTION III. Vehicles parking
in violation of no parking signs or
parked in areas designated for
the travel of vehicles or blocking
other vehicles in parking lots
referred to in Sections I and II,
may be removed and impounded
at the expense of the owner of the
vehicle impounded.

SECTION IV. Jurors may park
longer at the Walla Walla County
Courthouse parking lot during
jury duty upon the display of a
proper parking permit in the
front window of the vehicle.
