

ORDINANCE NO. 167

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS ADJACENT TO THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1 In order to make this Resolution relating to the operation of motor vehicles on certain County Roads, known as (see attached "EXHIBIT A"), in Walla Walla County, Washington, consistent with the provisions of the Laws of Washington, as amended or as hereafter amended, the following are hereby adopted and by this reference made a part hereof:

Washington Motor Vehicle Act, Chapter 309, 1927;  
Washington Highway License Act, Chapter 189, 1937; and  
Washington State Highway Act, Chapter 53, 1937.

Section 2 Any person violating any terms of the laws referred to in Section 1 of this Resolution within the bounds to be hereafter mentioned shall be guilty of a violation of this Resolution.

Section 3 It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of the following: 25 miles per hour on any street or road specifically mentioned in the following description or any speed posted by the County Engineer on any street or road in the following description:

(see attached "EXHIBIT A")

Section 4 Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Resolution, or who shall counsel, aid, or abet any such violation or fail to comply shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$ 250.00.

Section 5 If any of the proposed provisions of this Resolution are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Resolution shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6 This Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage.
