

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF THE FEE SECTIONS OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 159, COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 109 AND COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 44 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS, The County Board of Health has adopted a comprehensive environmental health fee schedule, and

WHEREAS, retaining the fee requirements in existing County environmental health ordinances would result in a duplication, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walla Walla Board of County Commissioners acting as the County Board of Health does ordain that:

SECTION I.

- a) Section II (fees for permits) of County Ordinance No. 159 and amendments thereto are hereby repealed, and
- b) That portion of Section I of County Ordinance No. 109 and all amendments thereto providing for permit fees and which reads as follows: "(a) Item H. The fee shall be fifty dollars and shall accompany the application", are hereby repealed, and
- c) That portion of Section I of County Ordinance No. 109 and all amendments thereto pertaining to fees for sewage contractors' licenses and which reads as follows: "The fee shall be \$60.00 for the original license and \$35.00 for annual renewals", are hereby repealed, and
- d) Section 4 of County Resolution No. 44 and all amendments thereto which pertains to sewage system cleaners' registration fees, are hereby repealed.

### NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 10:30 A.M. Tuesday, March 29th, 1983 in the office of the Board at the County Courthouse in Walla Walla on the following proposed Ordinance:

#### PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A COMPREHENSIVE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE WALLA WALLA COUNTY-CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, RCW 70.05.060 provides that the Walla Walla County Board of Health shall establish fees for issuing or renewing licenses and permits and for such other services as authorized by law, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Walla Walla Board of County Commissioners acting as the Walla Walla County Board of Health does hereby ordain that the following fee schedule be established for the environmental health services of the Walla Walla County-City Health Department:

#### SECTION I.

##### Sewage Program

- a) Septic Tank Permits (new and replacement systems) - \$50.00
- b) Sewage System Cleaners License (New and renewal) - \$25.00-year
- c) Sewage System Installers License - Initial - \$60.00-year
- d) Sewage System Installers License - Renewal - \$35.00-year

#### SECTION II.

##### Water Program

- Bacteriological Water Analysis - Out of County Samples Only - \$8.00-test

#### SECTION III.

- a) Restaurant or Restaurant with Bar - \$40.00-year
- b) Tavern - \$40.00-year
- c) Retail Fish or Meat Market - \$40.00-year
- d) Vending or Catering Kitchen - \$40.00-year
- e) Grocery Store with Meat Market - \$40.00-year
- f) Grocery Store without Meat Market - \$25.00-year
- g) Concession Stand - \$20.00-year
- h) Limited Concession Stand - \$15.00-year
- i) Mobile Food Unit without Base in County - \$40.00-year
- j) Mobile Food with Base in County - \$10.00-year
- k) Vending Machine Operation with Machines Only - \$10.00-year
- l) Temporary Food Service Establishments - \$3.00-day.

The payment of food service establishment fees shall not be required from charitable nonprofit organizations.

#### SECTION IV.

- a) Sanitary Landfill - Initial Permit - \$200.00-year
- b) Sanitary Landfill - Renewal Permit - \$50.00-year
- c) Drop Box Sites - Initial Permit - \$50.00-year
- d) Drop Box Sites - Renewal Permit - \$25.00-year
- e) Composting Sites - Initial Permit - \$200.00-year
- f) Composting Sites - Renewal Permit - \$50.00-year
- g) Sludge Utilization Sites - Initial Permit - \$200.00-year
- h) Sludge Utilization Sites - Renewal Permit - \$50.00-year
- i) Other Solid Waste Sites - \$25.00-year

#### SECTION V.

The above fee schedule shall take effect upon adoption.
