

ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 186 - WALLA WALLA COUNTY CODE-CHAPTER 8.12 - PERTAINING TO SEWAGE SYSTEM CLEANING REGULATIONS.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO INSURE THAT SEWAGE SYSTEM PUMPINGS REMOVED FROM SEWAGE SYSTEMS IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY ARE DISPOSED OF IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING SEWAGE DISPOSAL OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON AND/OR WALLA WALLA COUNTY AND TO INSURE THAT THE DISPOSAL OF SUCH SEWAGE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE OR CREATE A HEALTH HAZARD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners acting as the Board of Health of Walla Walla County, Washington:

1. Section 8.12.050 is amended as follows:

8.12.050 Method of Disposal & Records. Operators shall keep records showing the name and address of the customer, date pumped, person doing the pumping job and where disposal is made. These records shall be made available to the Health Officer upon request.

All sewage system pumpers who clean sewage systems in Walla Walla County, must dispose of the pumpings in the State of Washington at the sites approved by the jurisdictional health authority. If sewage pumpings are disposed of in Walla Walla County, disposal must be at an approved municipal or community sewage treatment plant or lagoon, but only with prior approval of the sewage system operator. Sewage pumpers are required to pay all fees associated with disposal at a treatment plant or lagoon. Sewage pumpings may be disposed of on the property from which they originate, provided that prior approval is received from the health officer on a case-by-case basis.

8.12.070 Violaton--Penalty. Anyone violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or to imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day a violation of this chapter continues shall be considered a separate offense.

4. There is hereby added to the Walla Walla County Code 8.12.040 which will read as follows:

8.12.040 Equipment. Vehicles used with pumping equipment attached must comply with all requirements applicable to commercial vehicles. Tanks shall be fully enclosed, strong enough for all conditions of operation, be leakproof, fly proof and operate to prevent spillage at all times. Equipment must be maintained so as not to be offensive or create a potential health hazard. All vehicles used in these operations shall carry in a conspicuous place the name of the firm or operator under which the business is conducted. Each vehicle permitted to operate under this chapter shall display in a conspicuous place on both sides of the vehicle the sign, REGISTERED BY THE WALLA WALLA COUNTY-CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT. The lettering shall be in plain letters at least two inches high. The Health Officer is authorized to conduct inspections of equipment to determine compliance with this chapter.

5. There is hereby added to the Walla Walla County 8.12.050 which will read as follows:

8.12.050 Method if Disposal & Records. Operators shall keep records showing the name and address of the customer, date pumped, person doing the pumping job and where disposal is made. These records shall be made available to the Health Officer upon request.

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If sewage pumpings from Walla Walla County are disposed of out of county, the disposal site must be approved by the jurisdictional health agency.
